World Trade Center Alaska Announces Trade Mission to Canada

World Trade Center Alaska and the Alaska Export Assistance Center, a unit of the U.S. Dept. of Commerce, will lead a trade mission to Alberta, Canada in September. From 17 through 22 September, the trade mission delegation will travel to Edmonton and Calgary. The mission coincides with the Oil Sands Trade Show & Conference and participants will attend the event. Mission members will also receive a guided tour of the oil sands development at Ft. McMurray. In addition, delegation members will meet with U.S. and Canadian government officials and private sector executives. The Canadian oil sands present numerous opportunities for a variety of sectors. The U.S. Commercial Service has identified the following six areas as potential opportunities for American businesses: oilfield services and supplies, project management, security systems, travel and tourism, telecommunications, and logistics.
