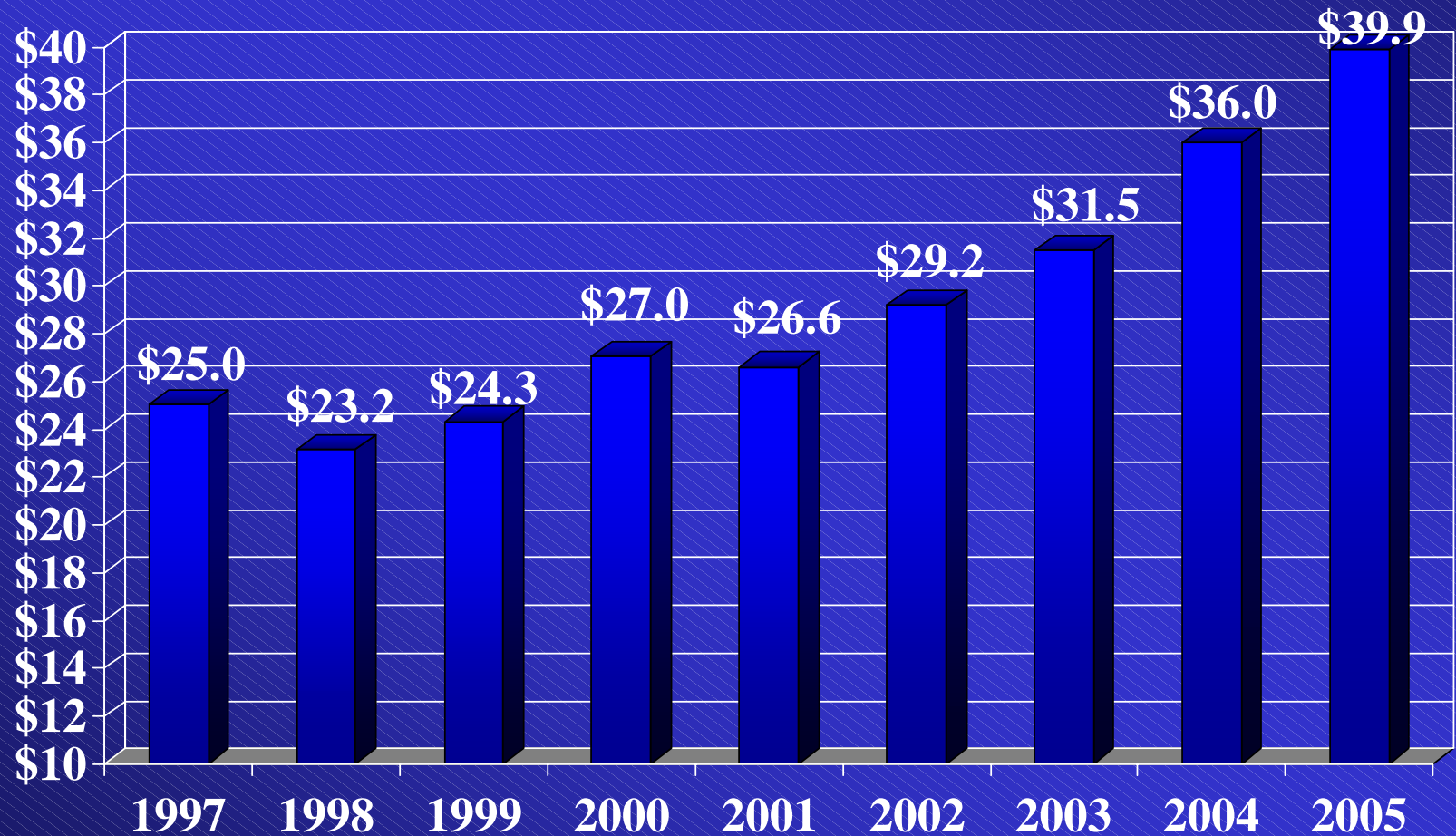

Alaska Gross State Product

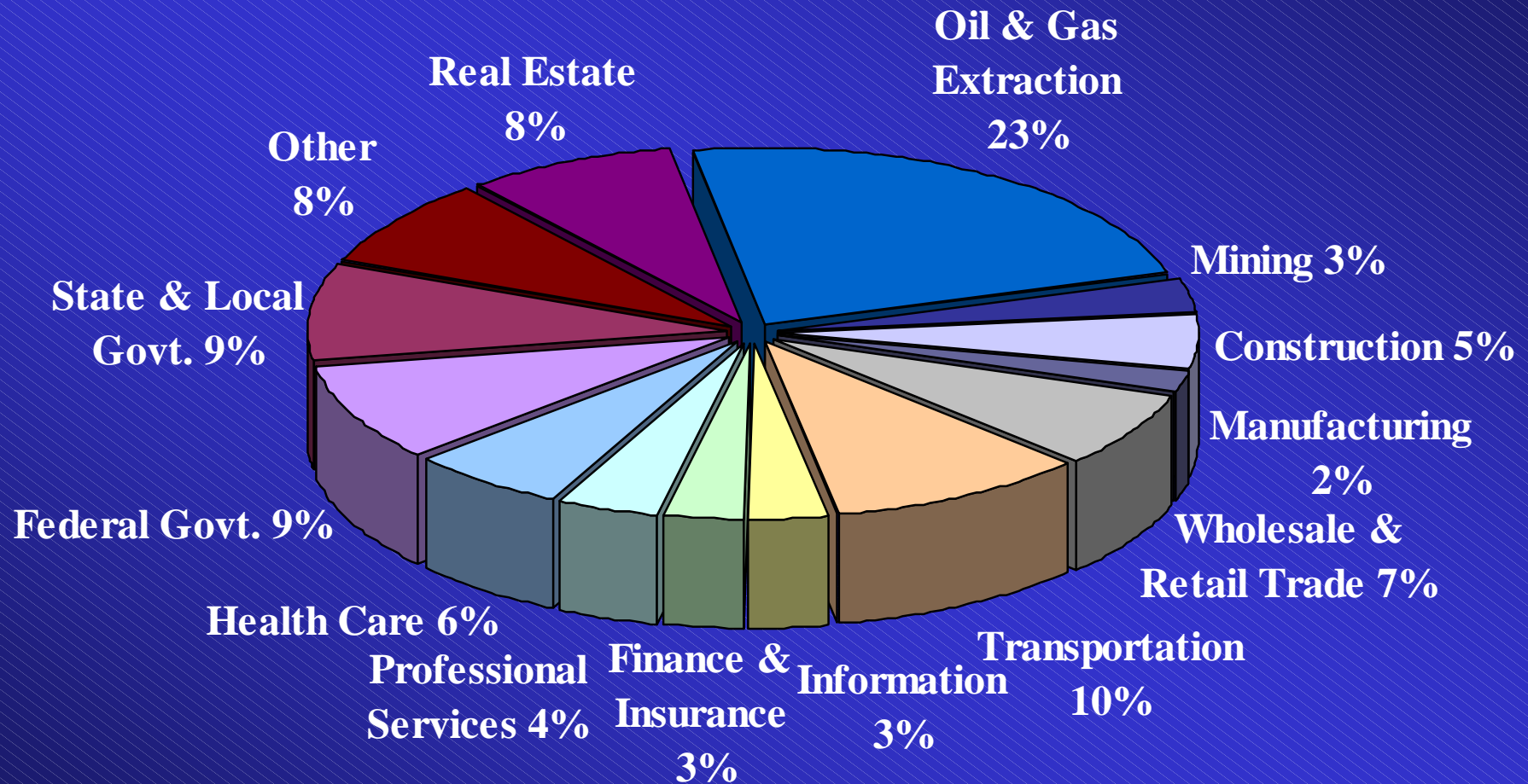
Billions of Current Dollars

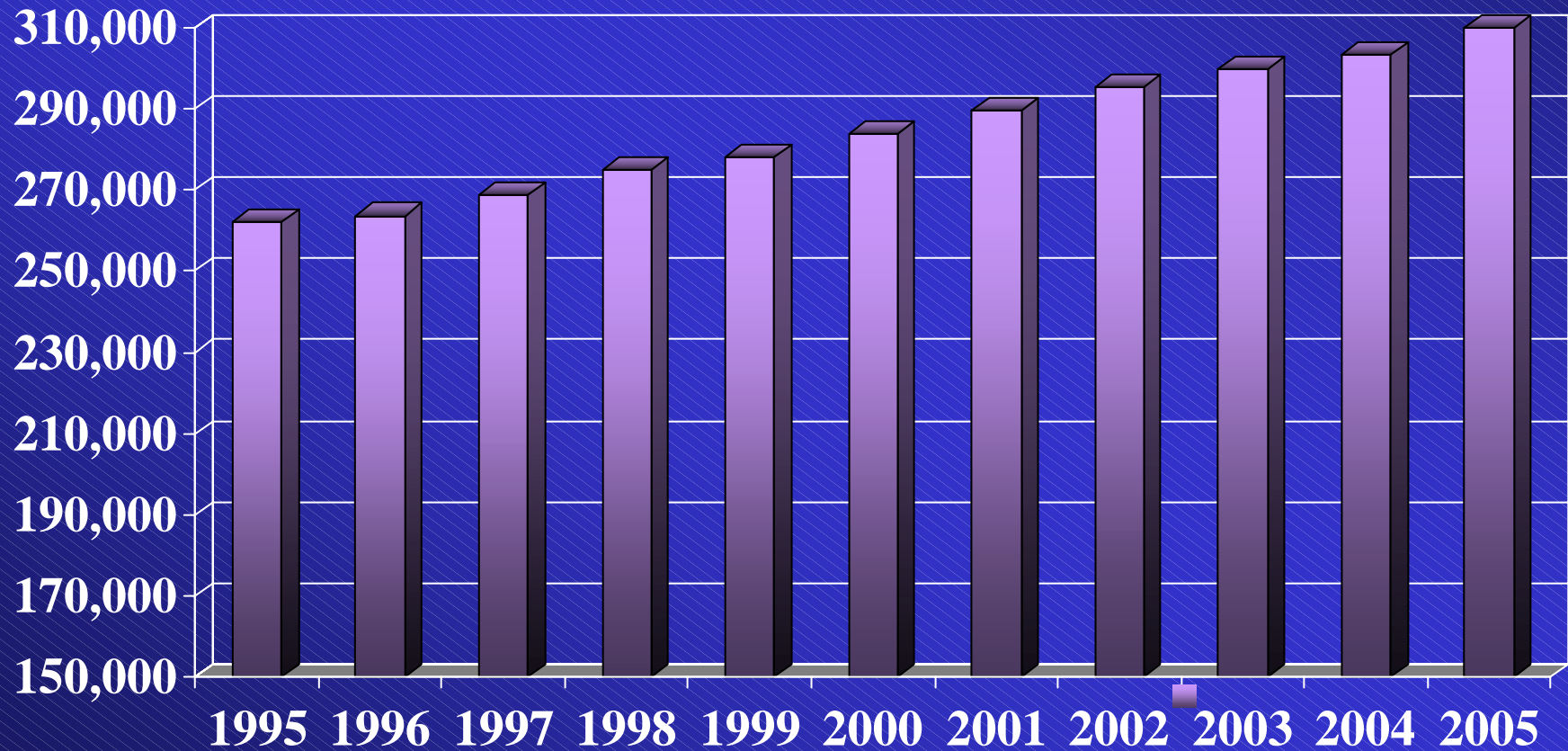

Total Payroll Jobs

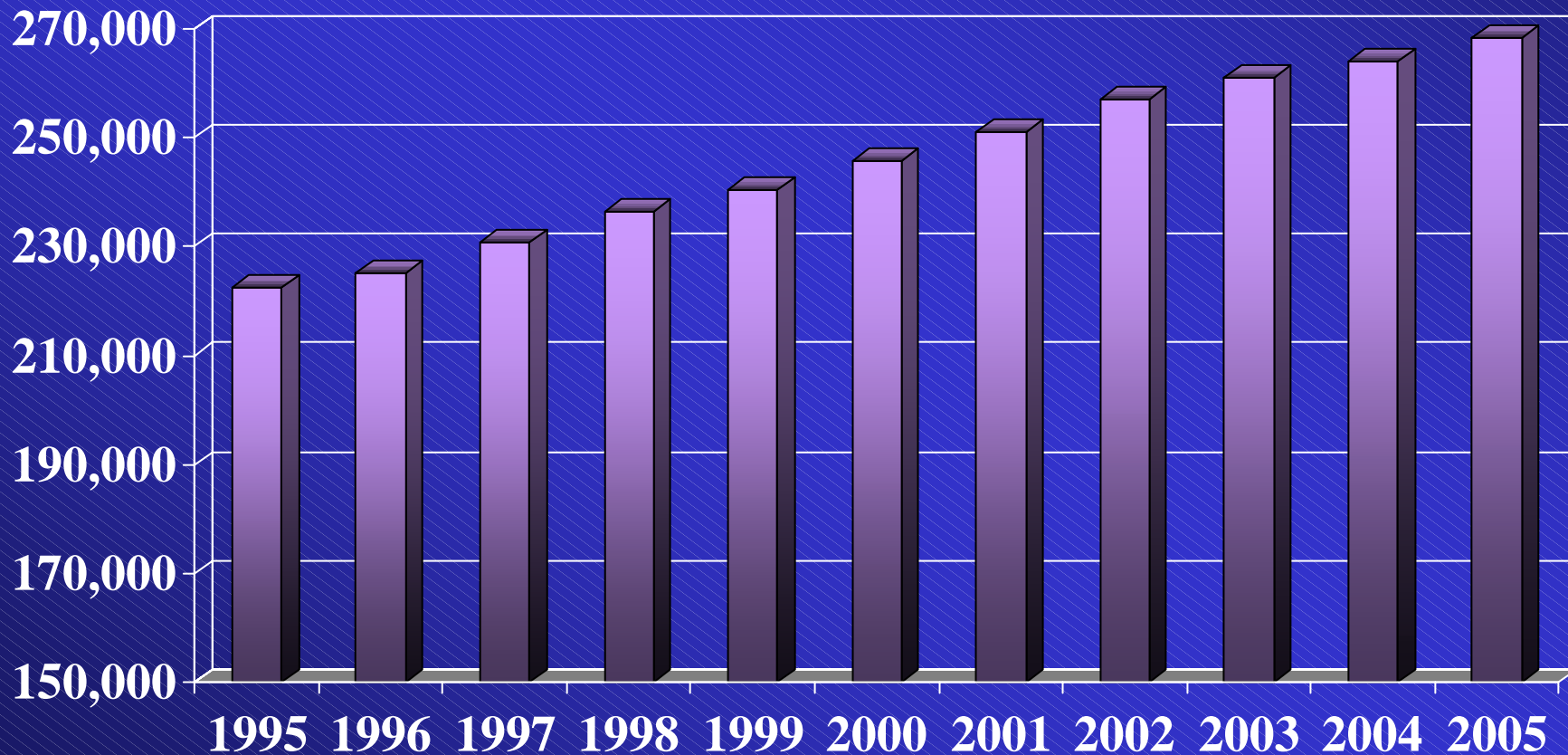

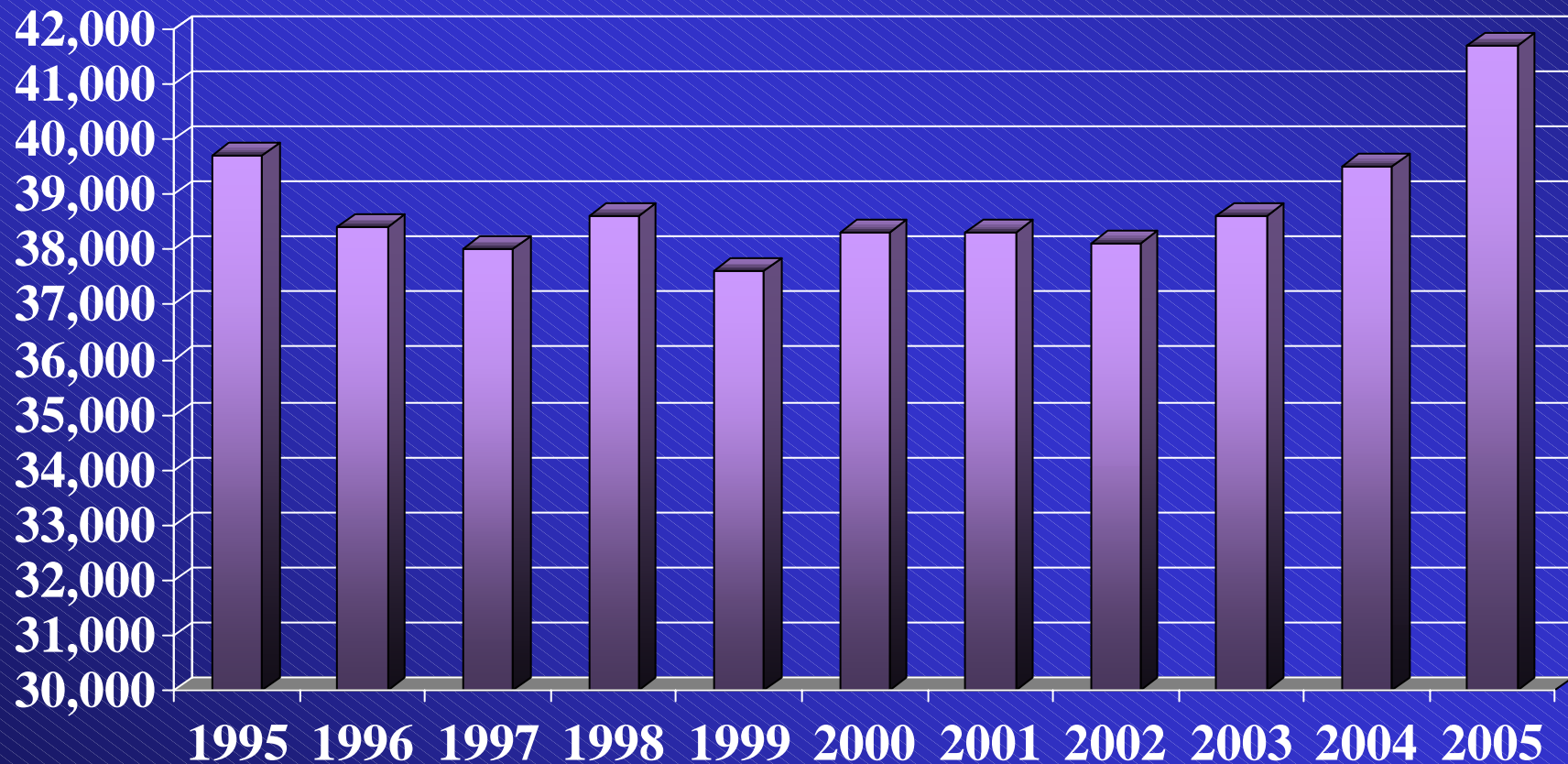

Goods Producing Jobs

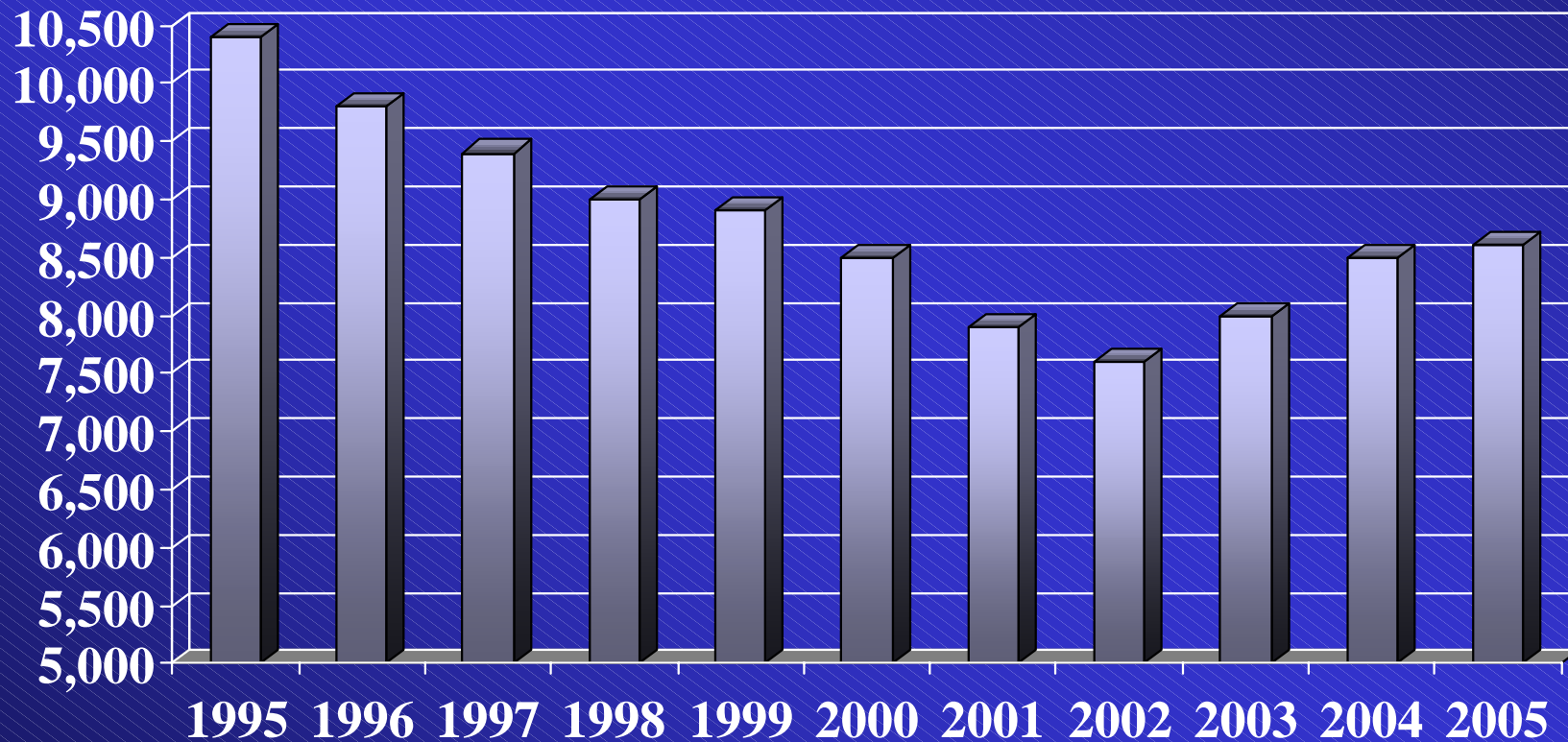

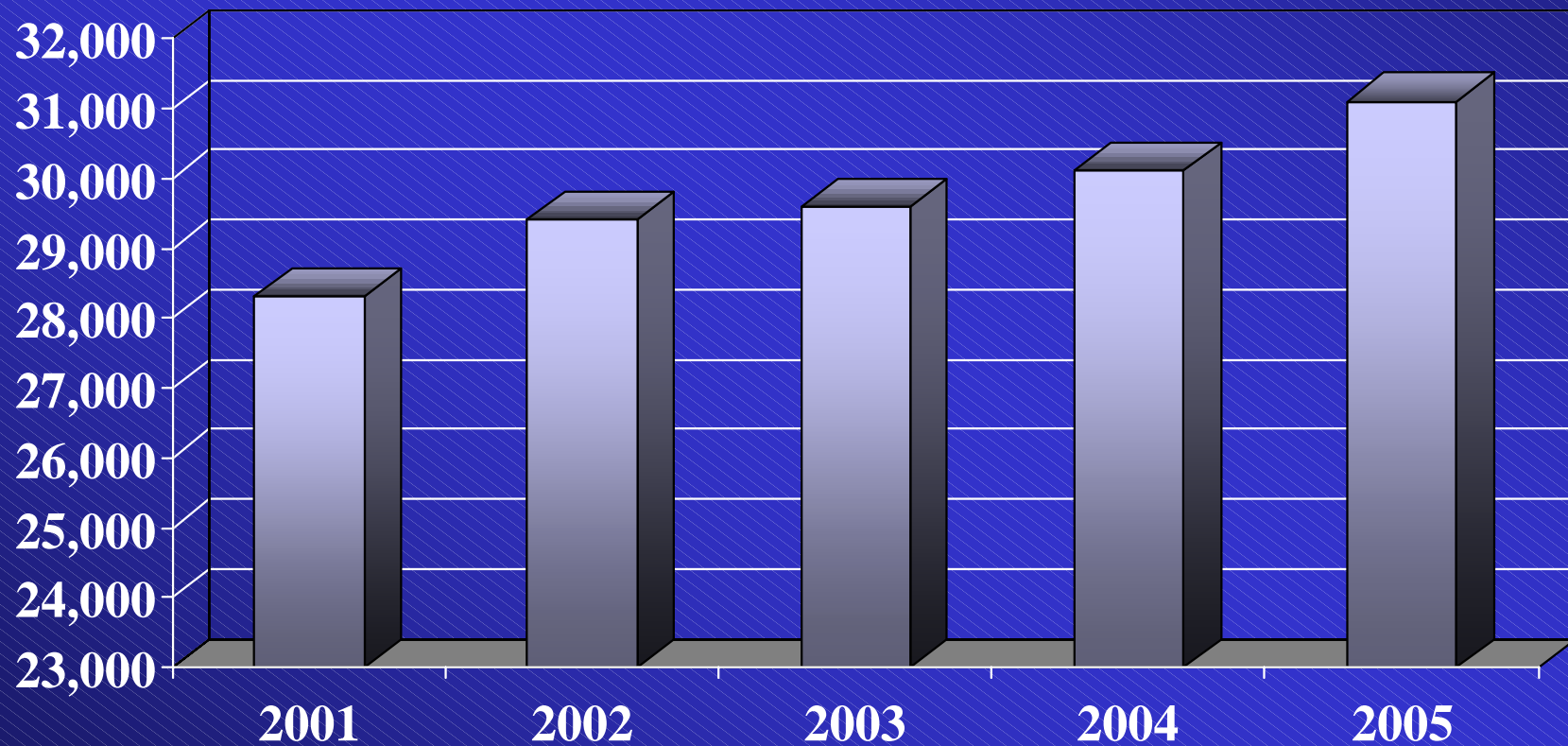

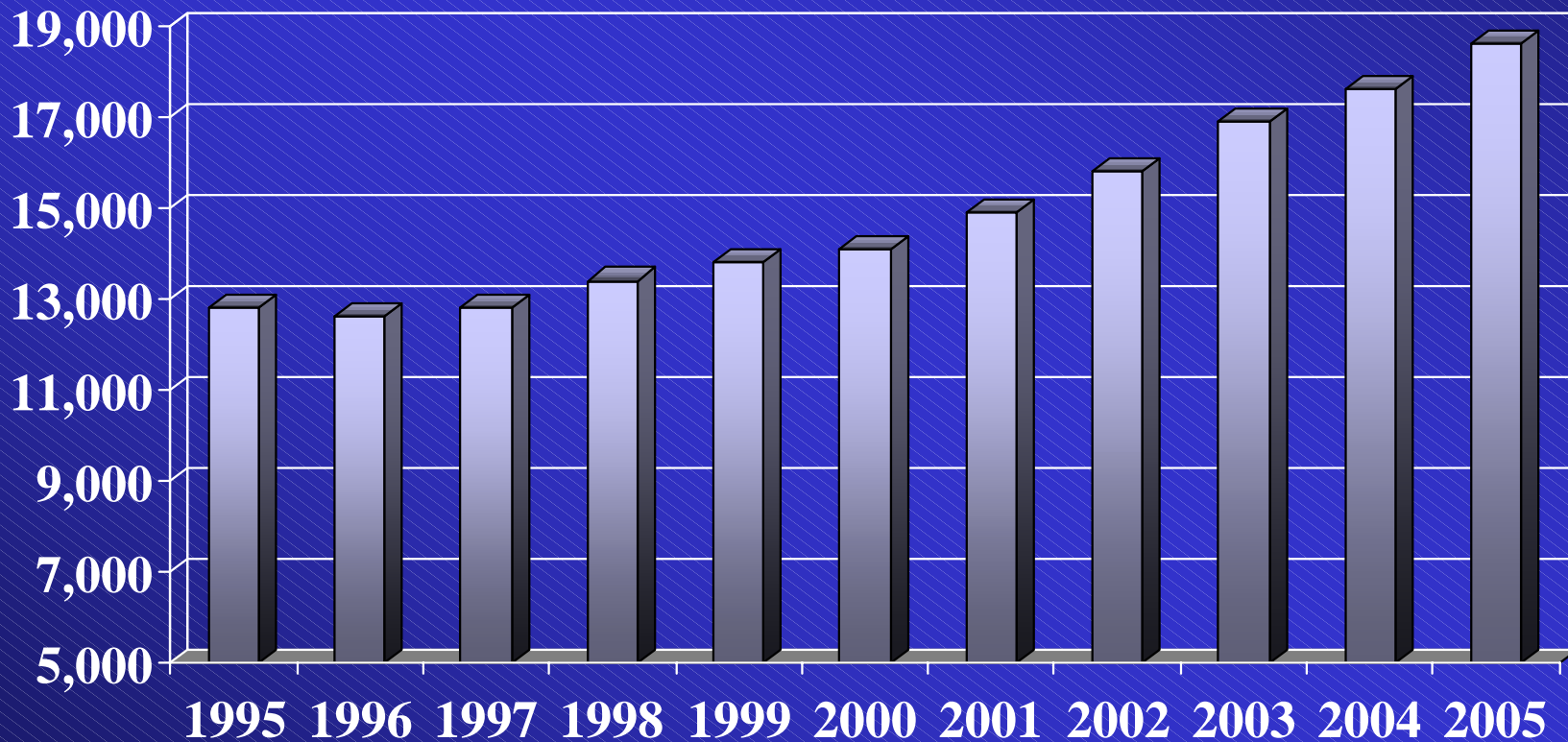

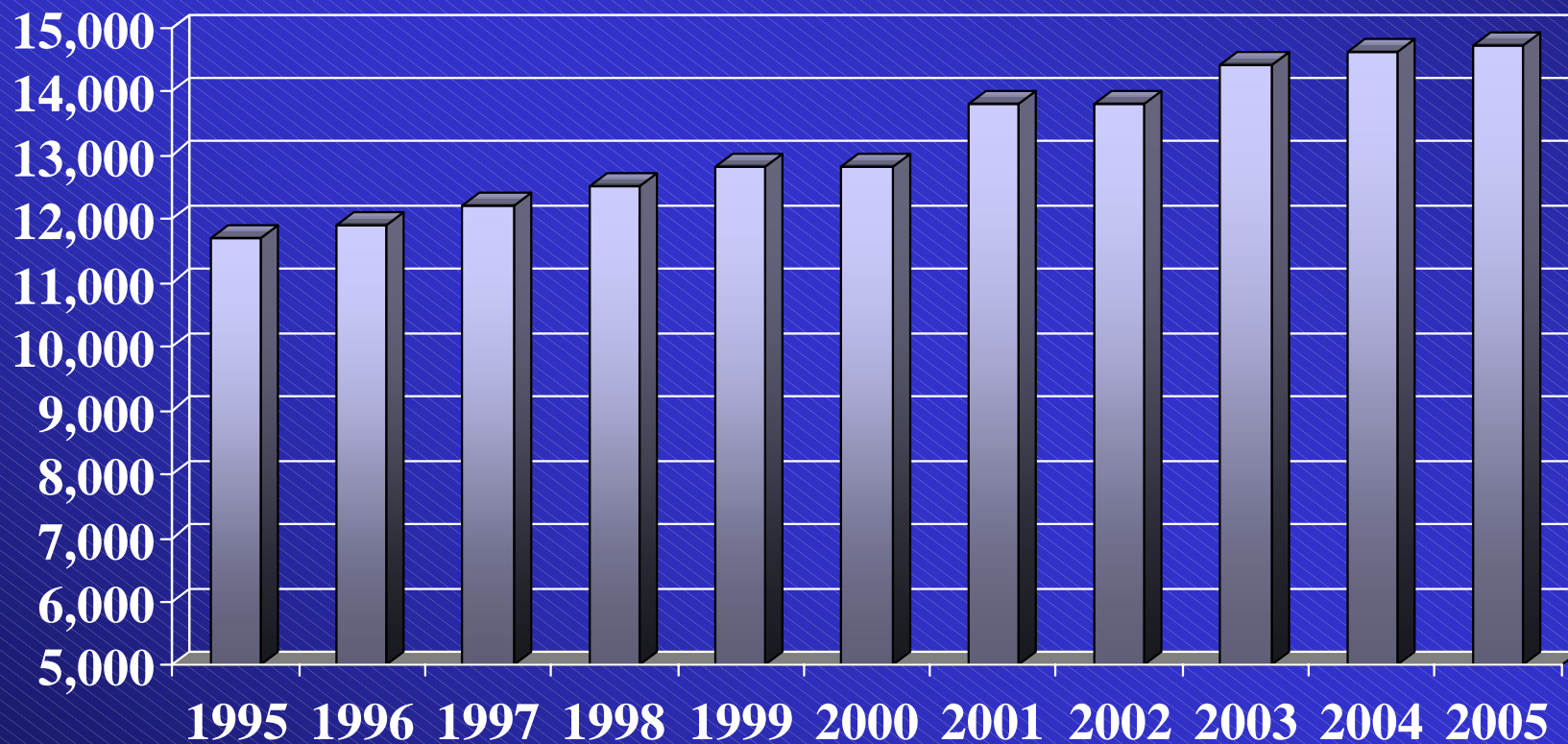

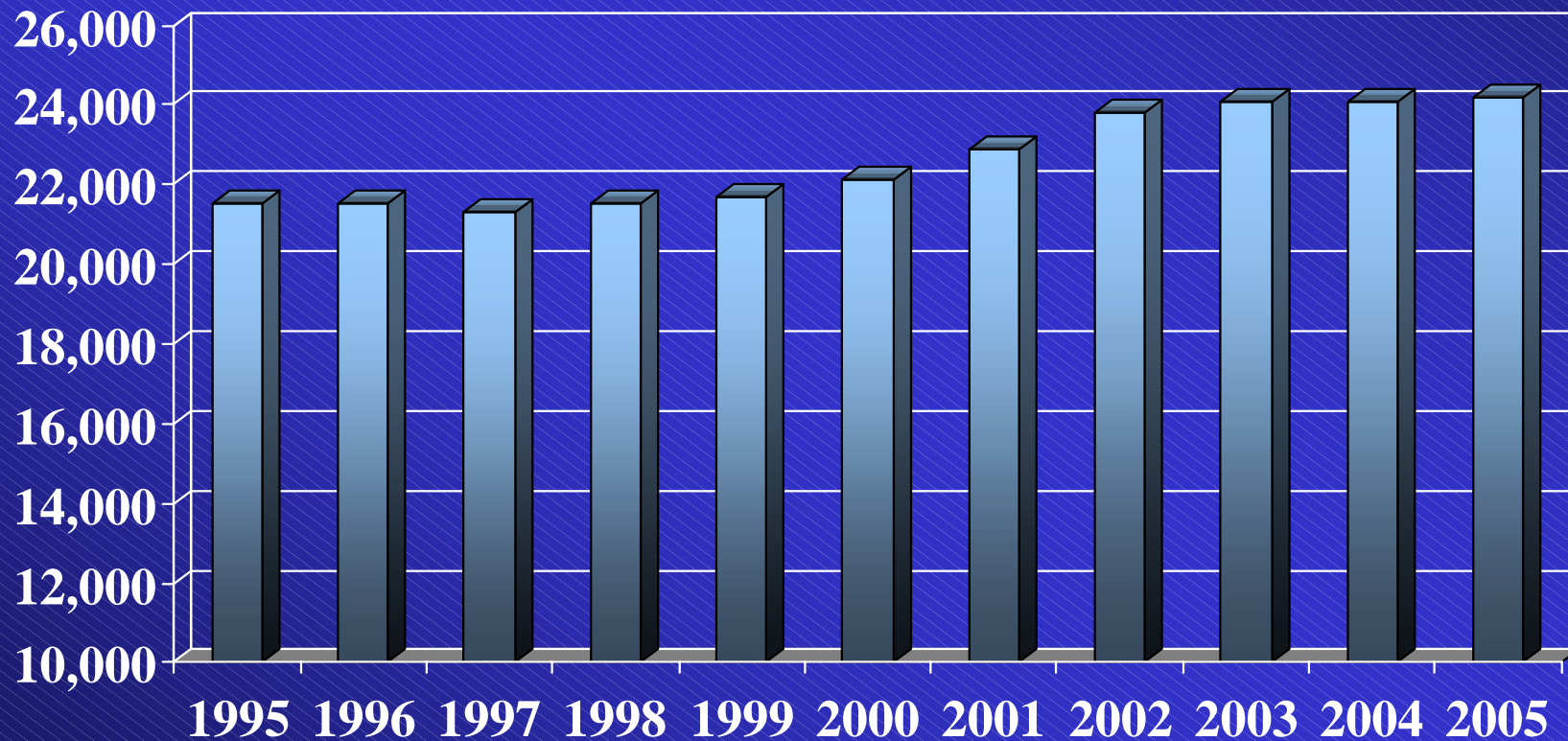

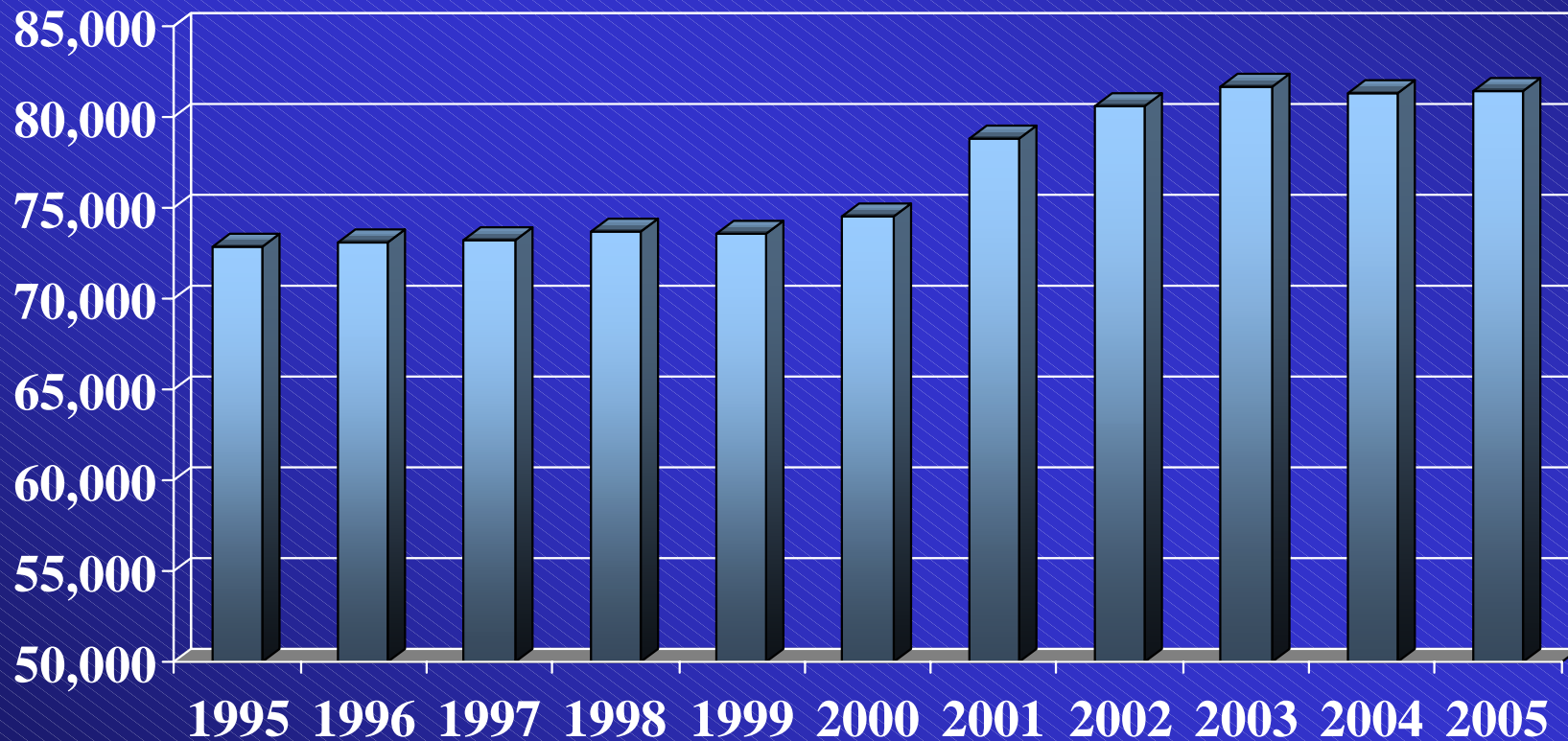
State Government Jobs

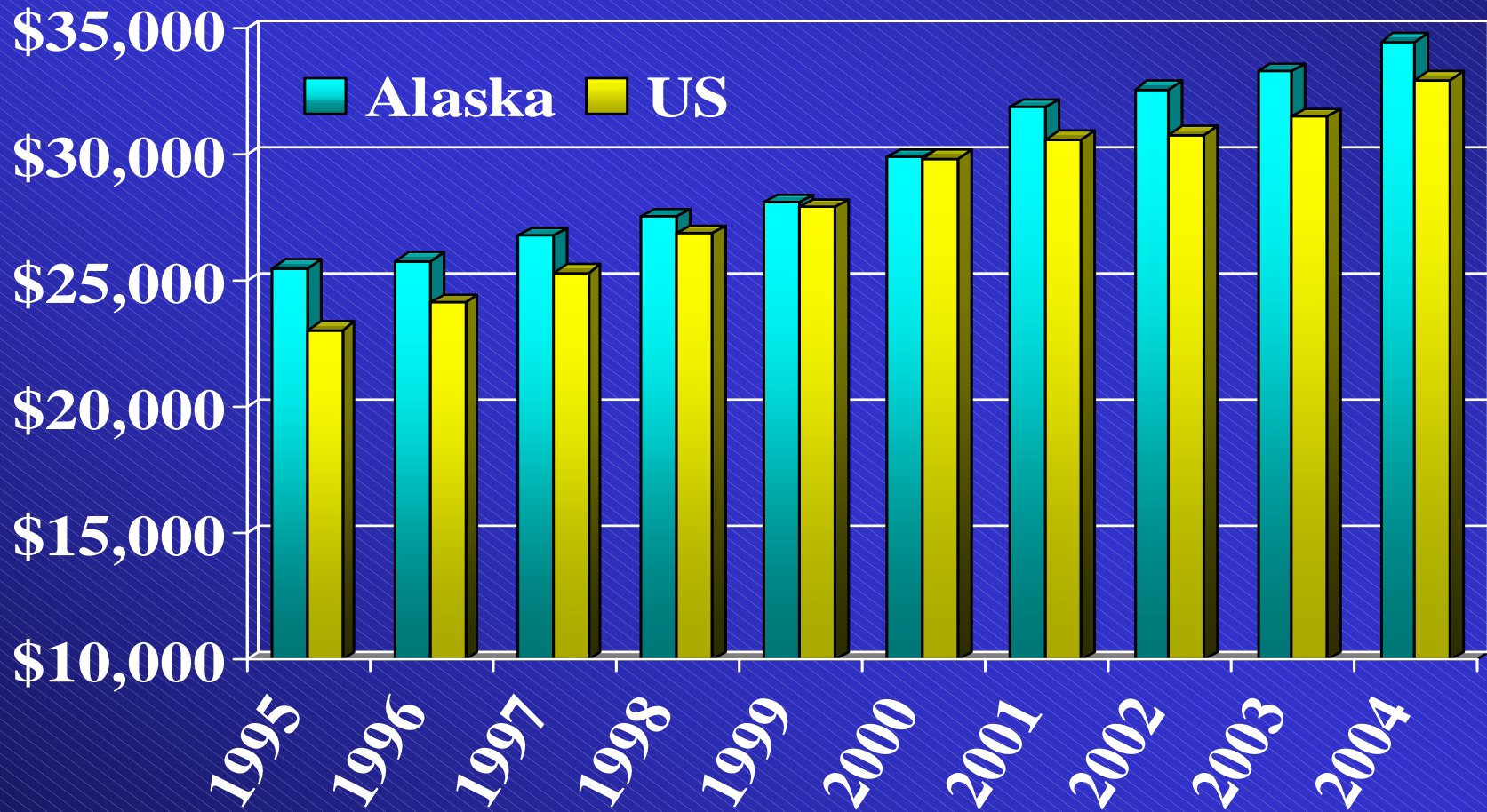
Alaska Total Federal, State, and Local Government Jobs

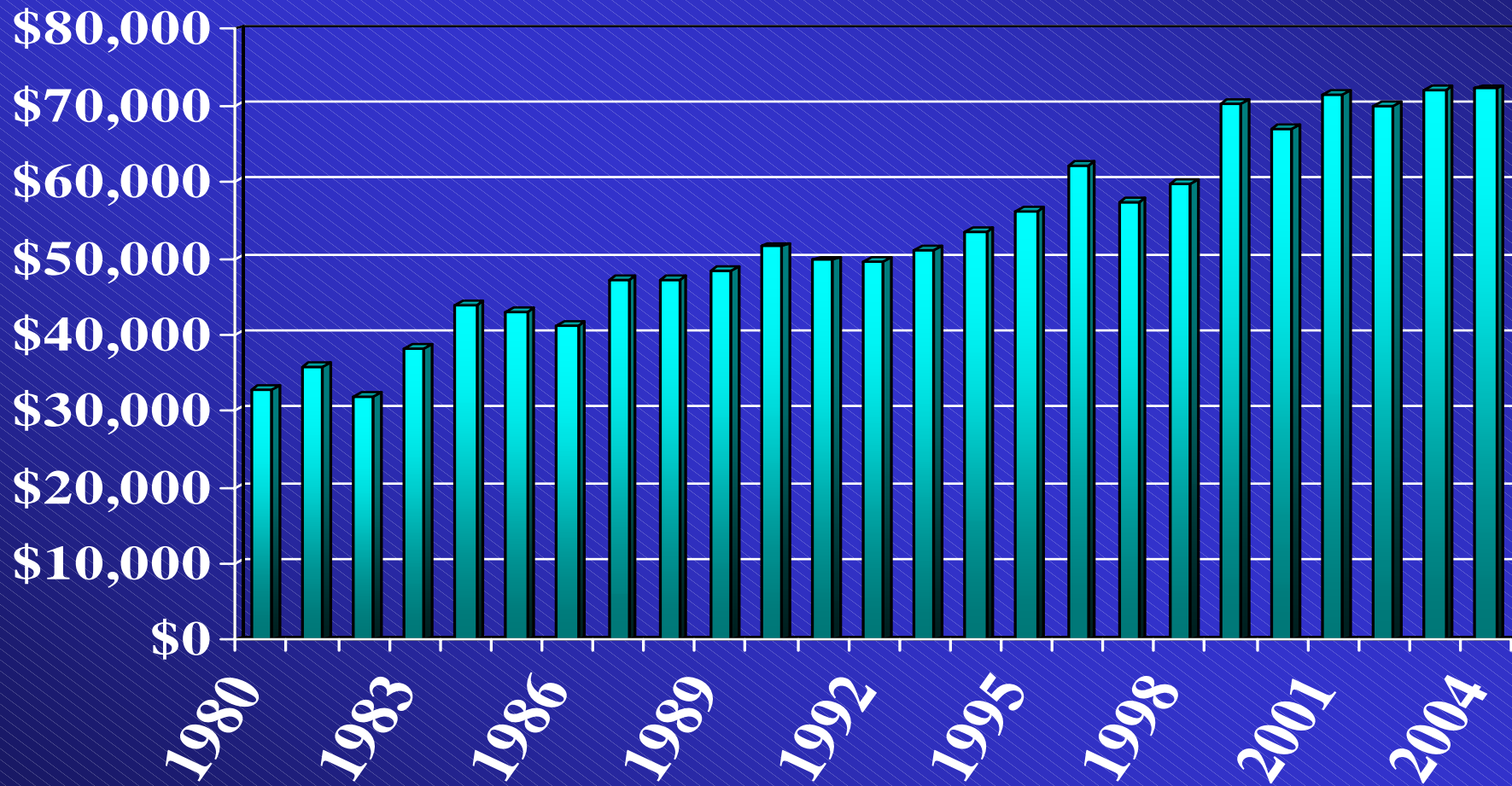
Alaska and U.S. Per Capita Personal Income

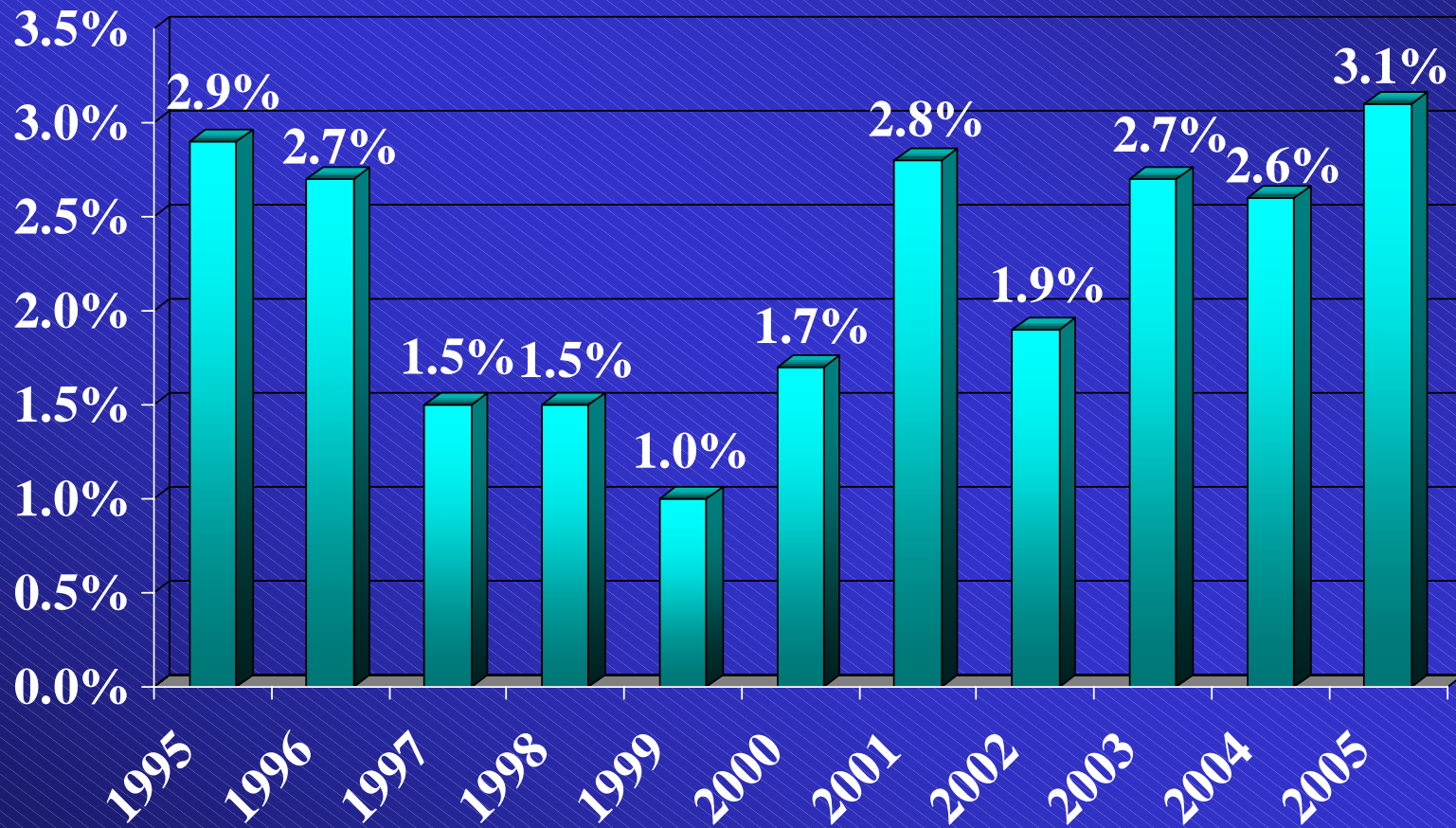
Alaska and U.S. Median Income, 4-Person Family

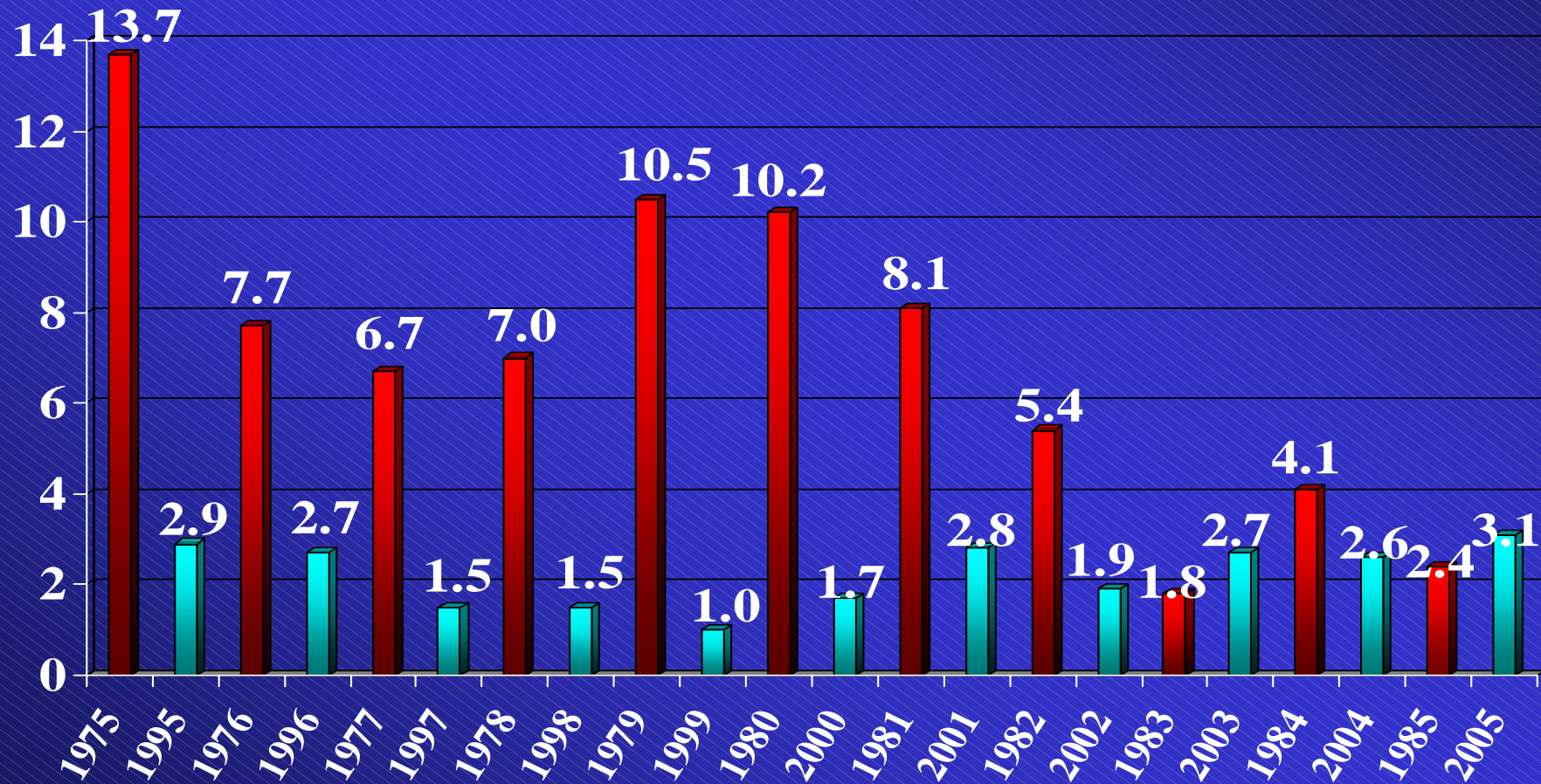
Anchorage Inflation

Anchorage Inflation Percentage %

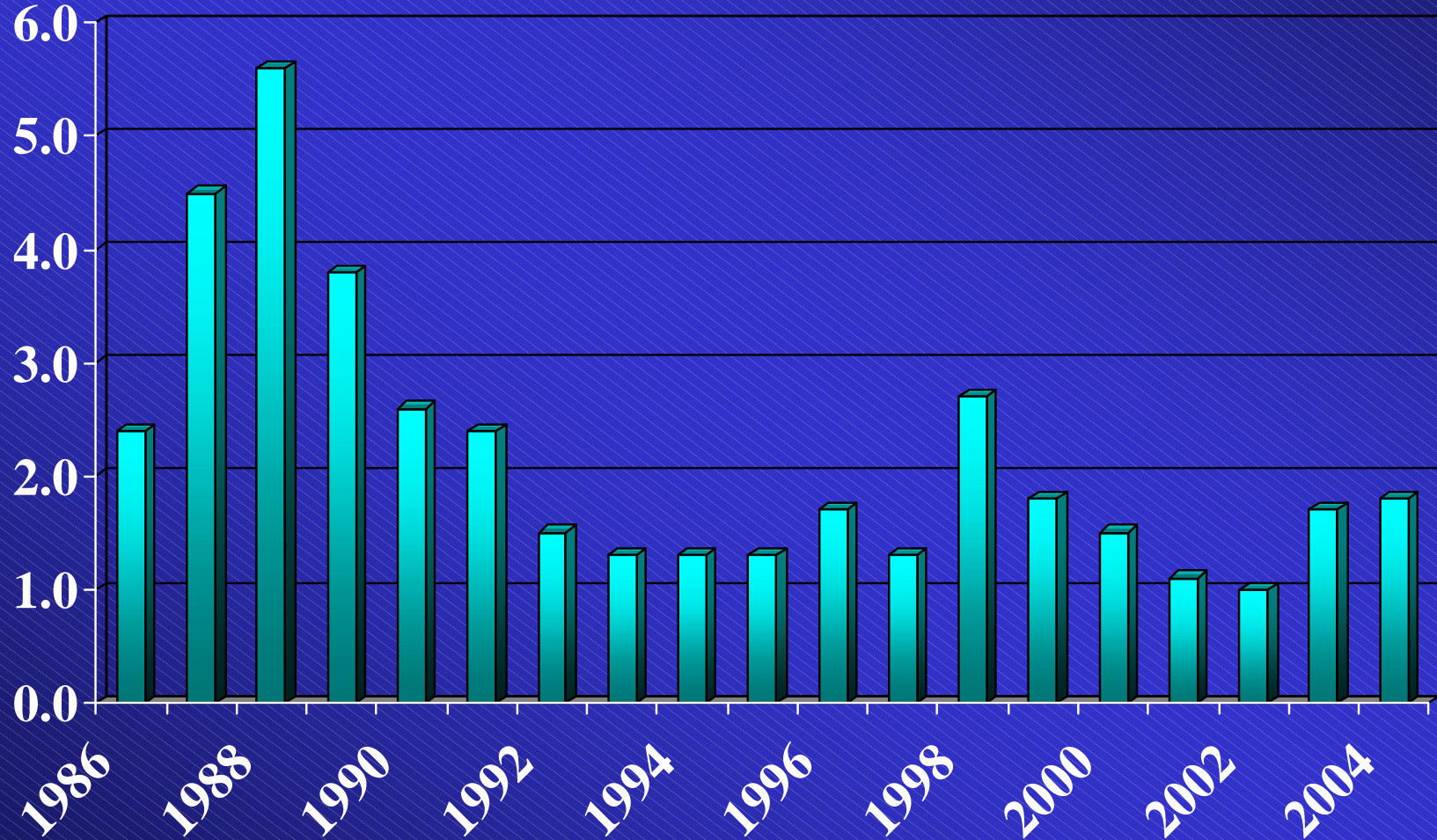

percent

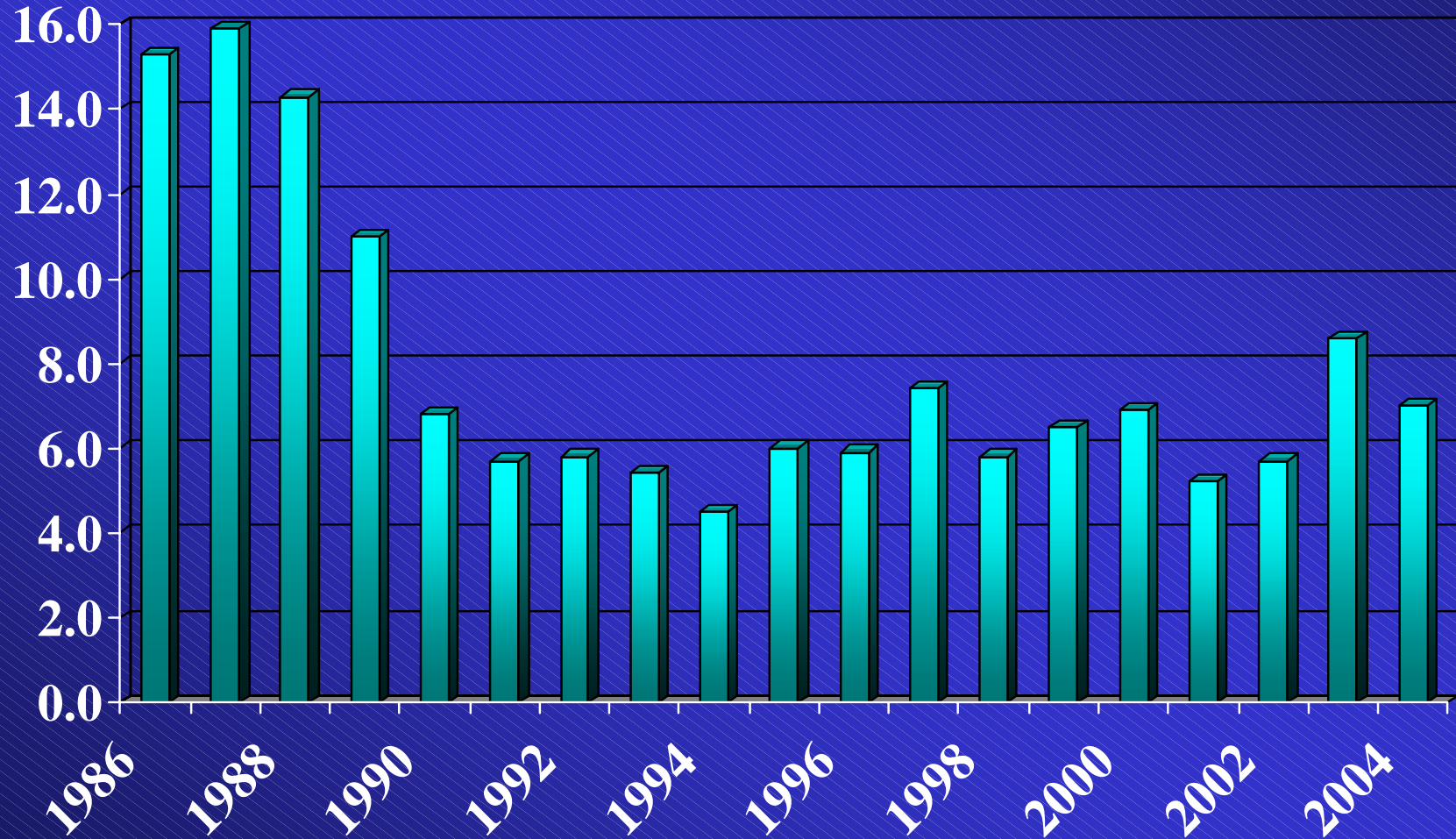

percent



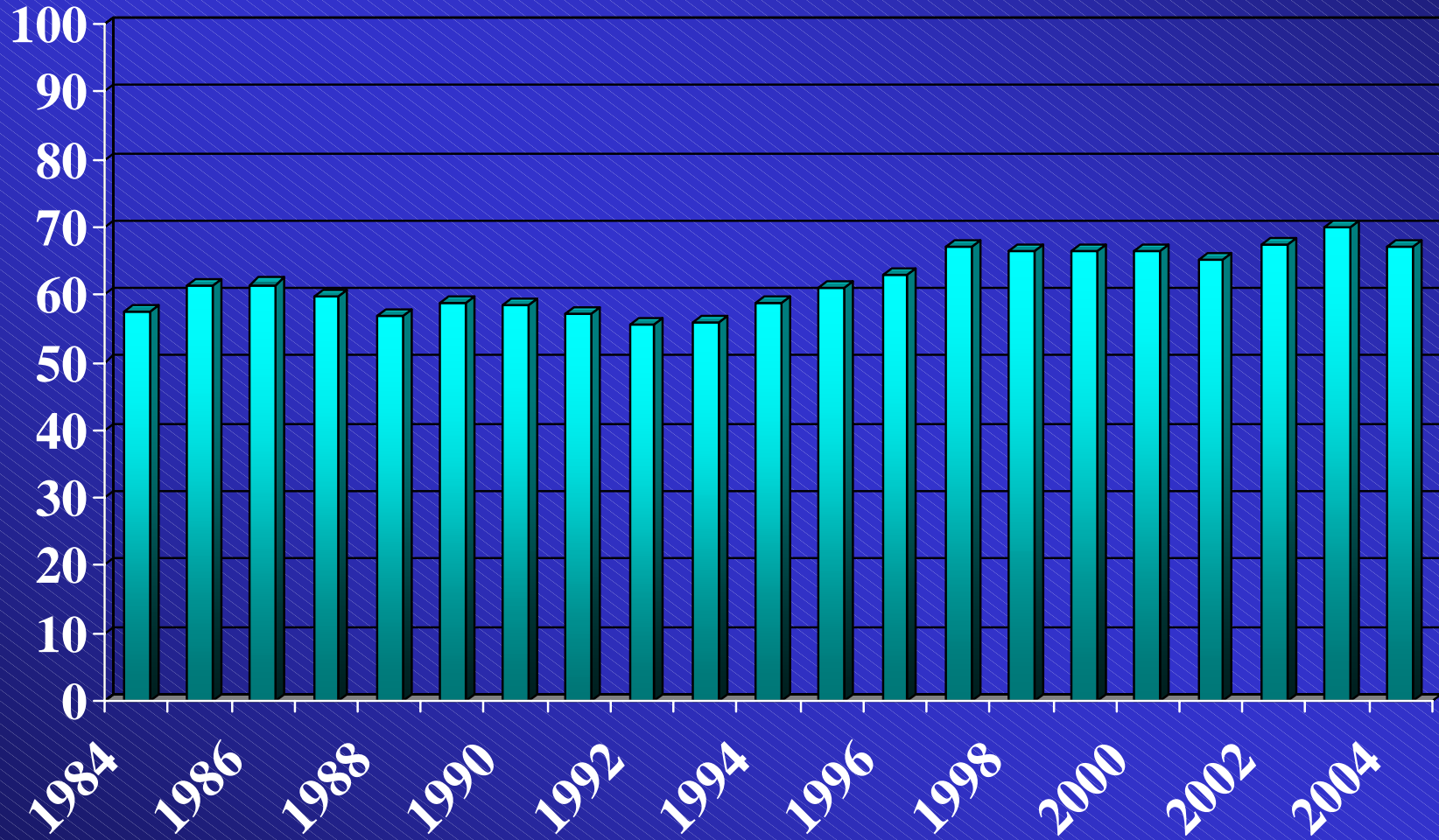

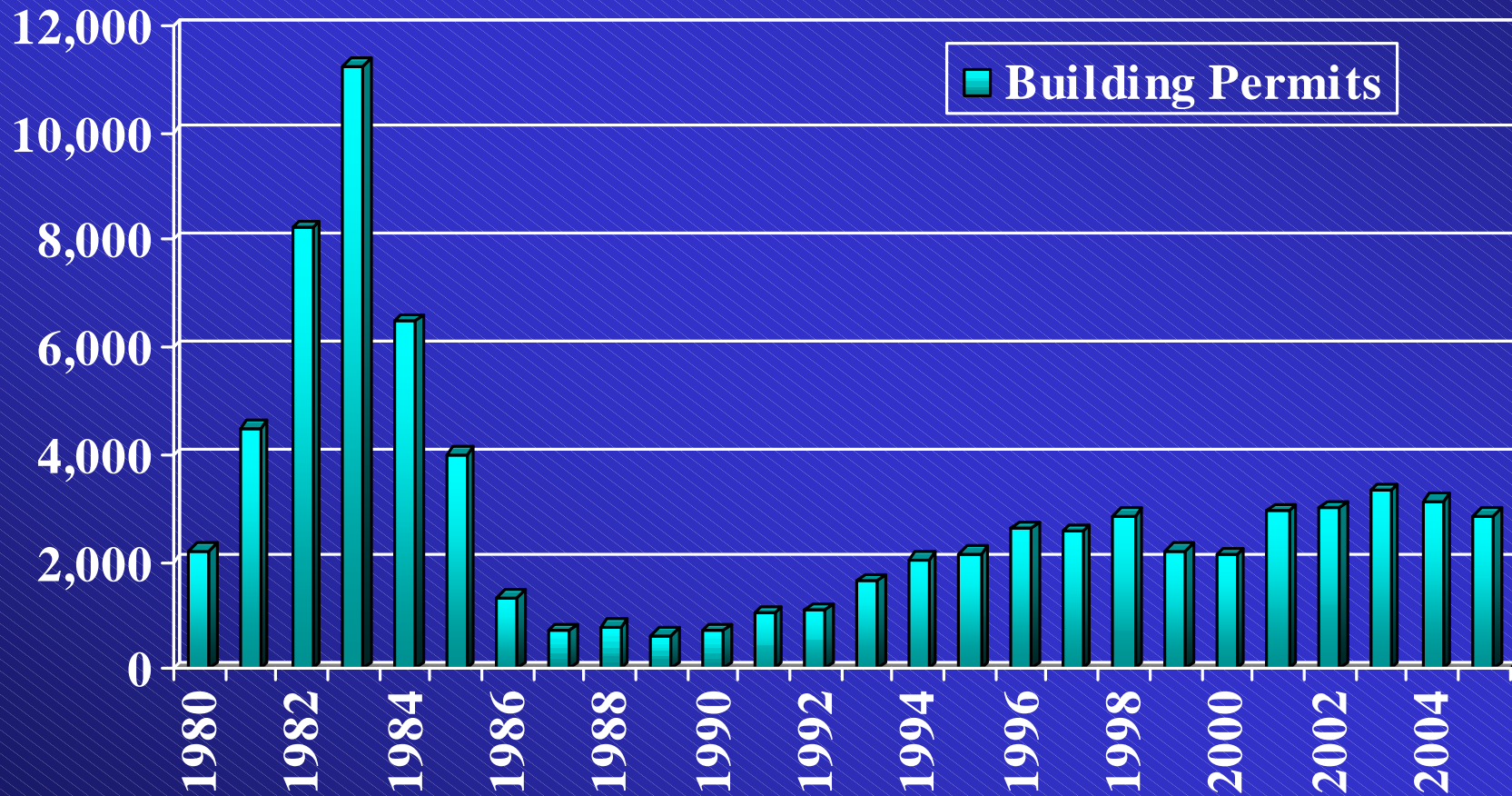

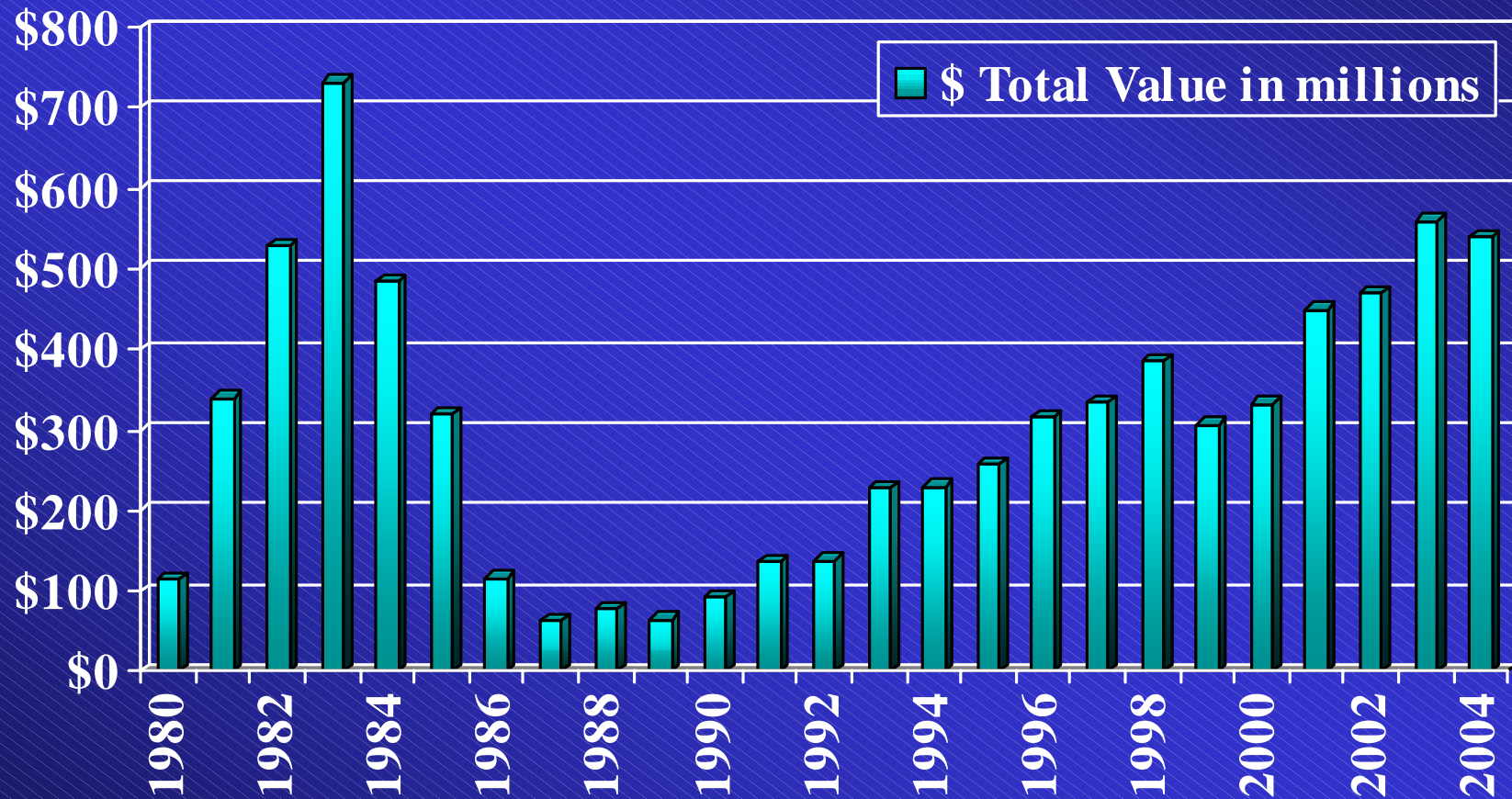

unadjusted dollars

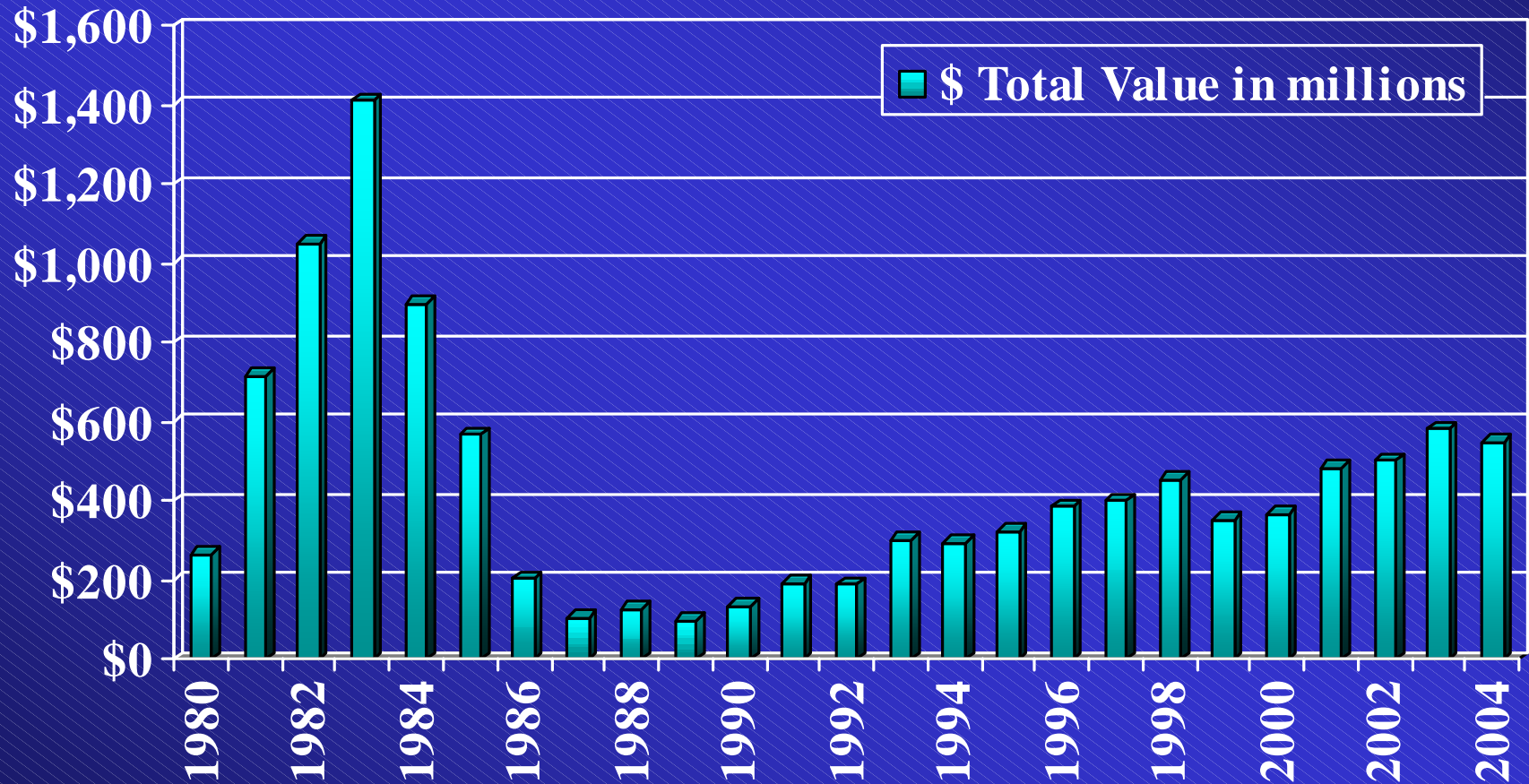

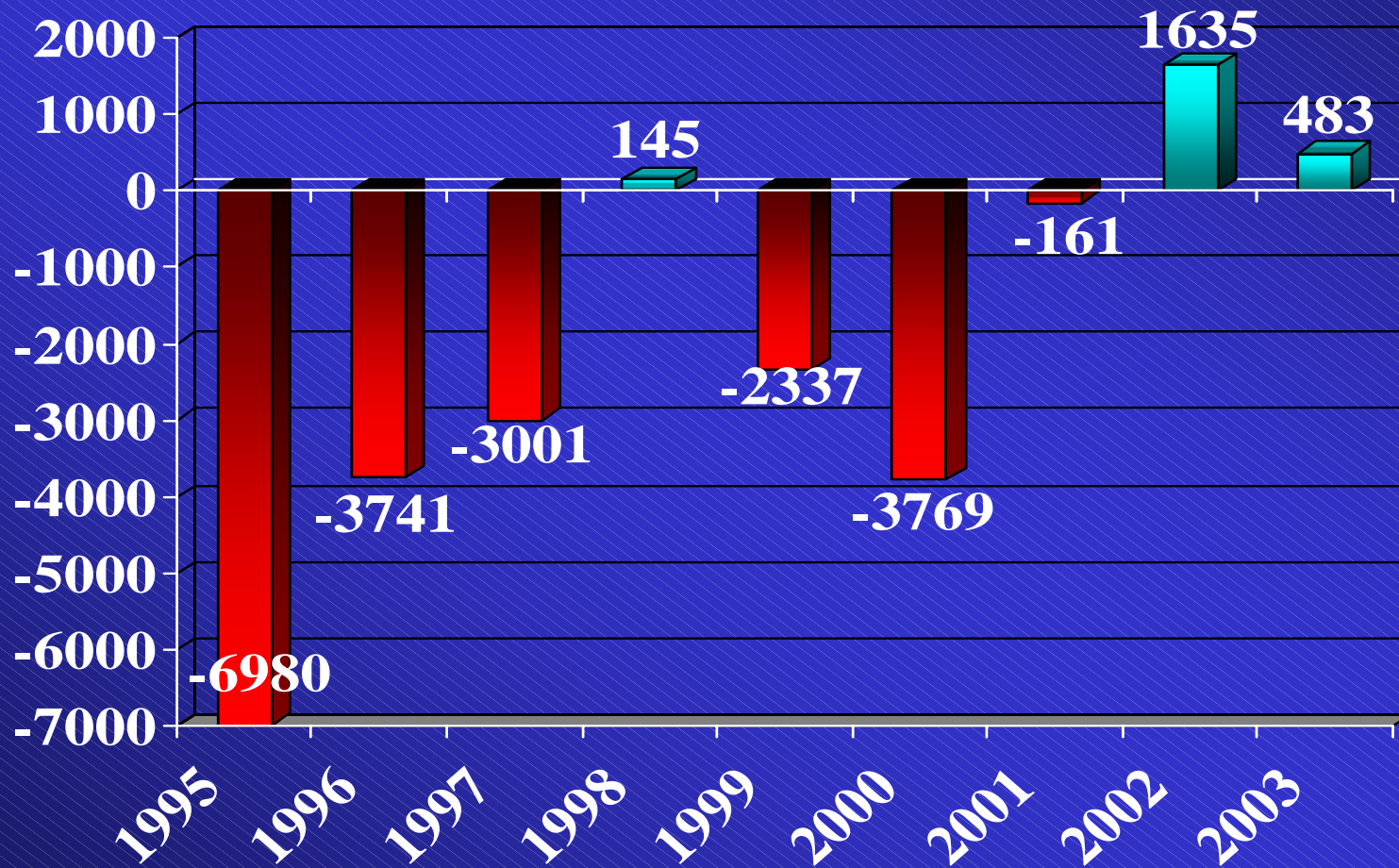
2005 current dollar equivalent

Alaska Net Population Migration

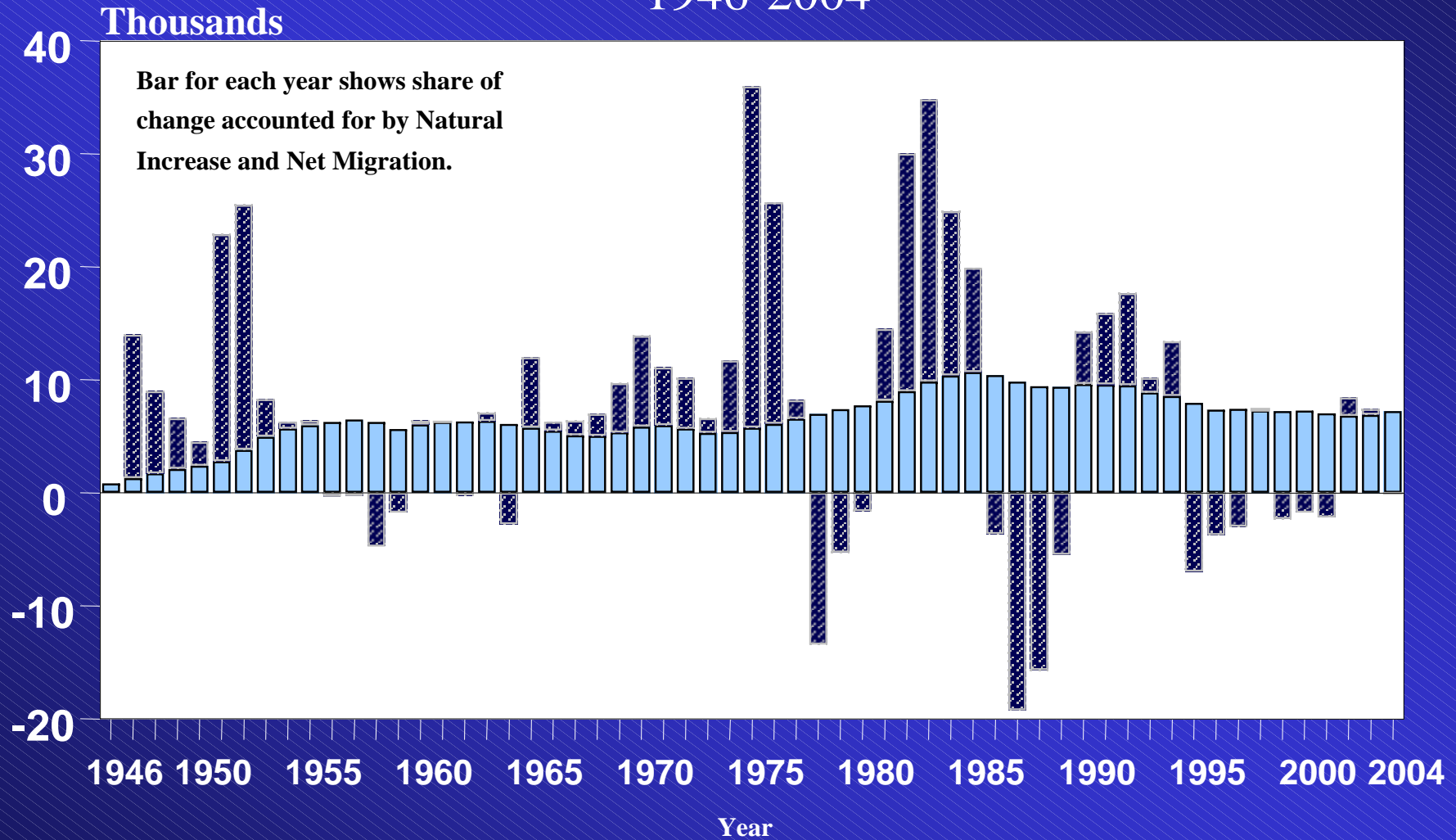

1946-2004



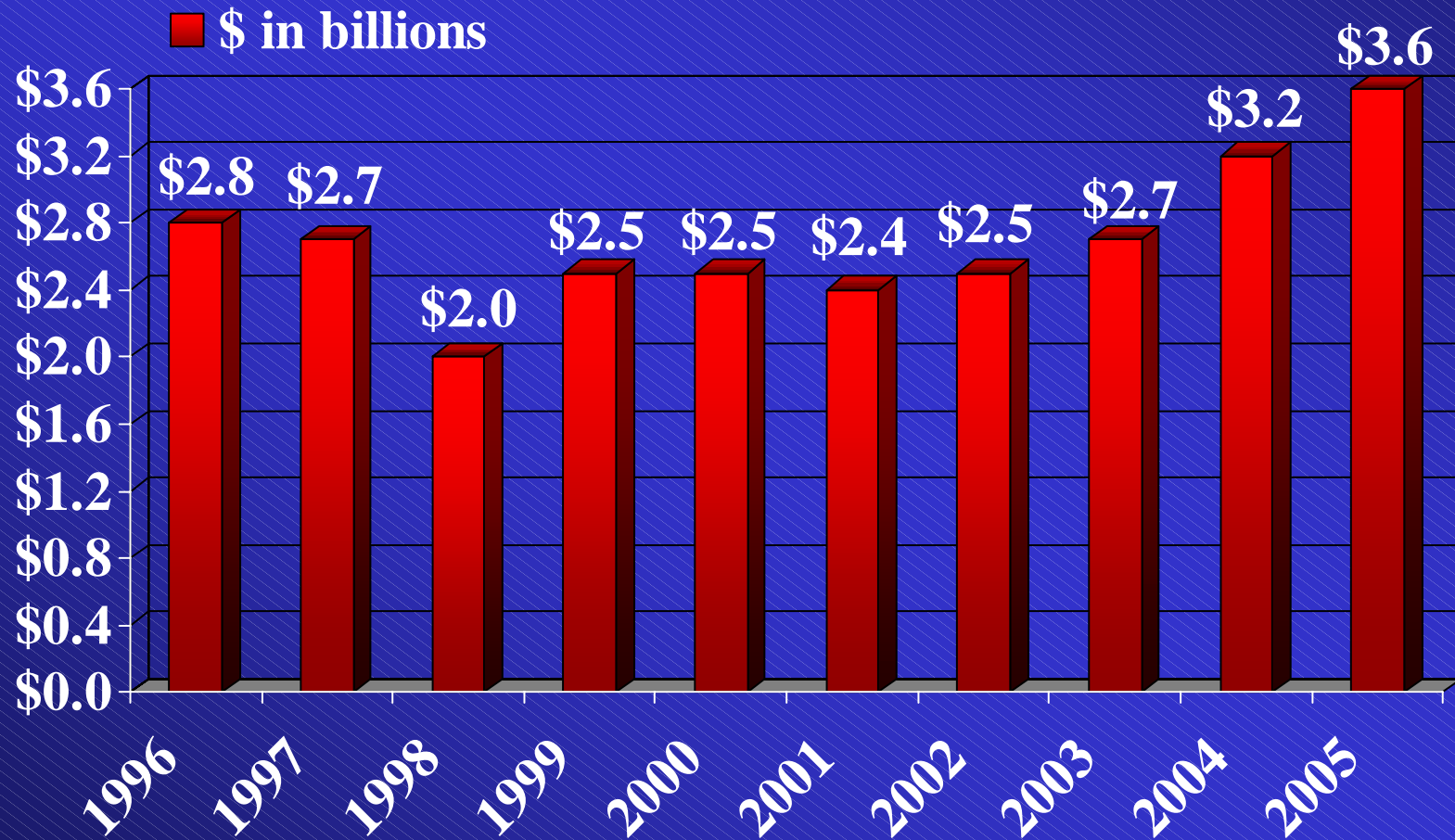

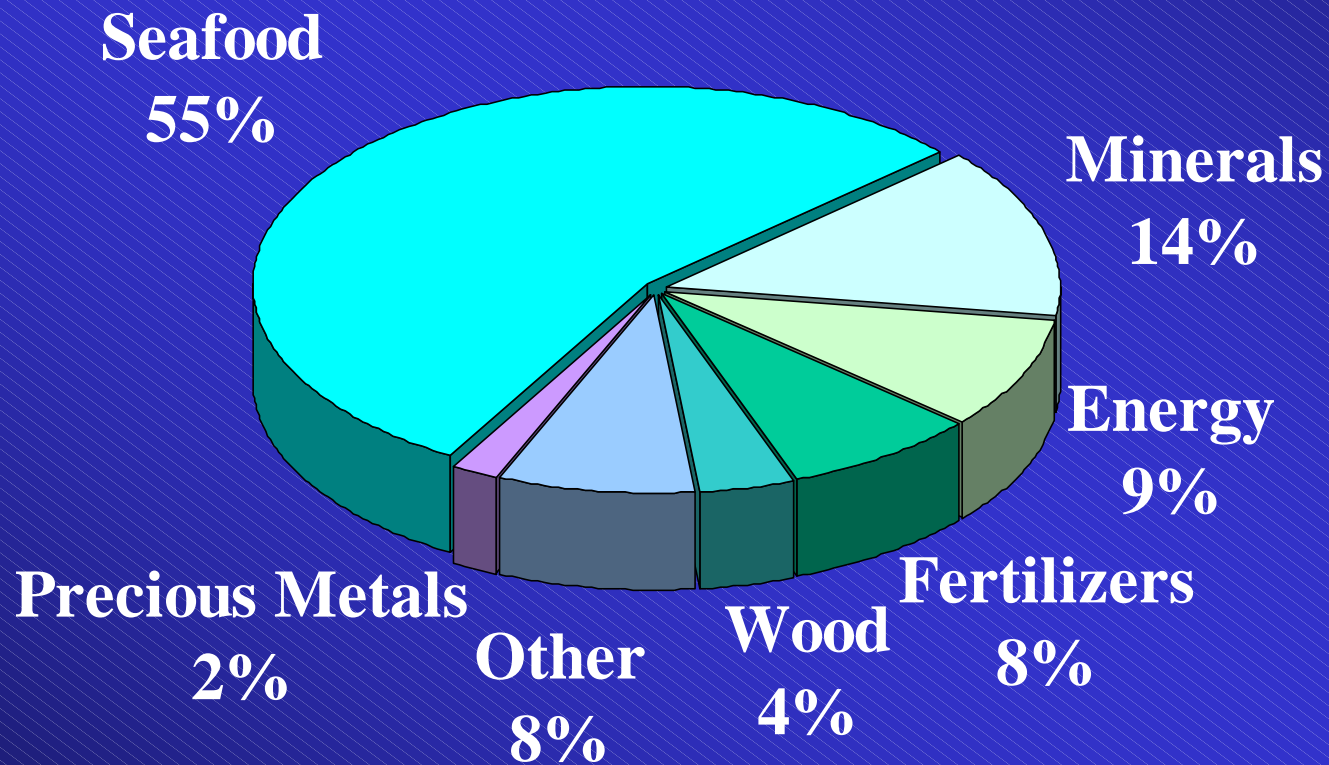

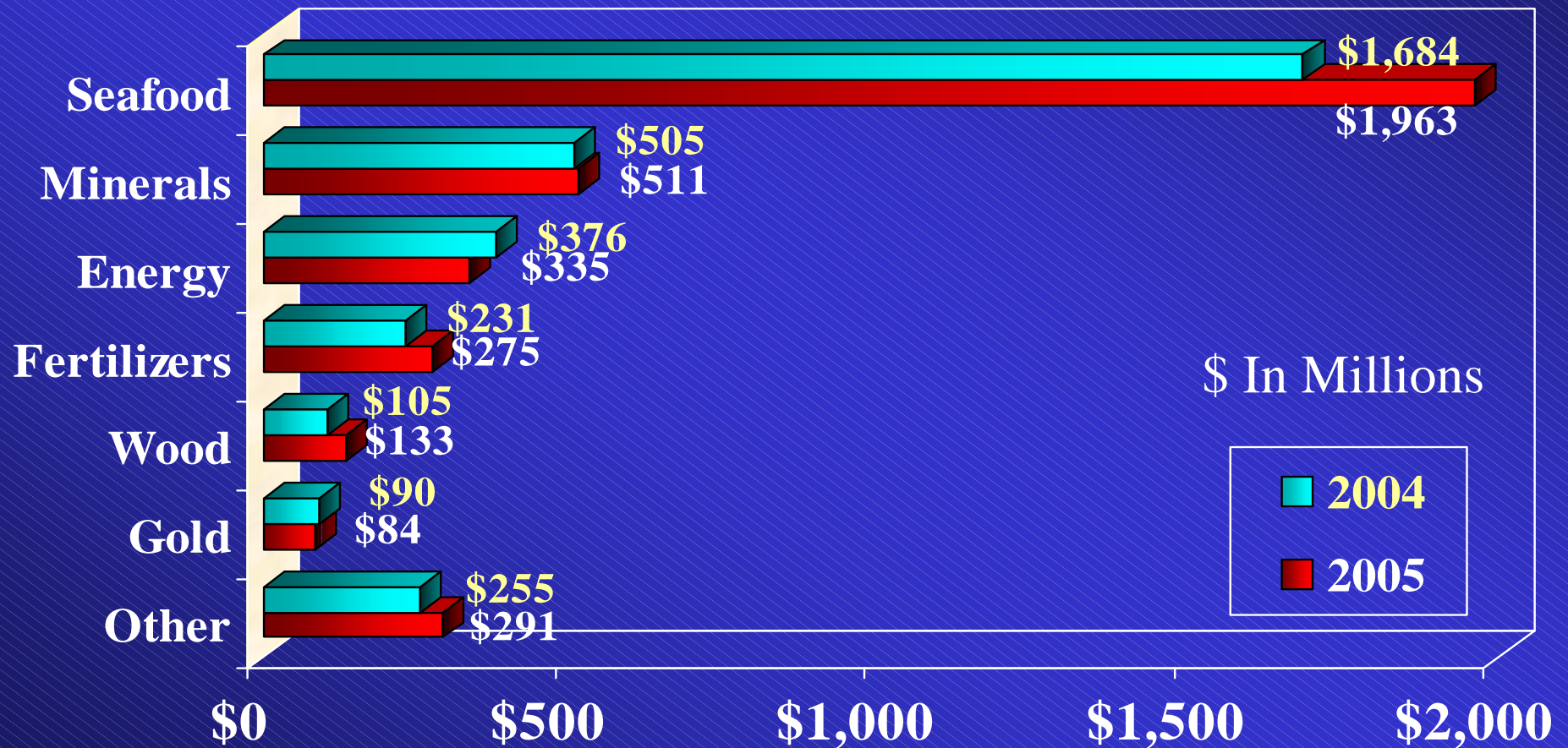
Alaska's International Export Products 2005

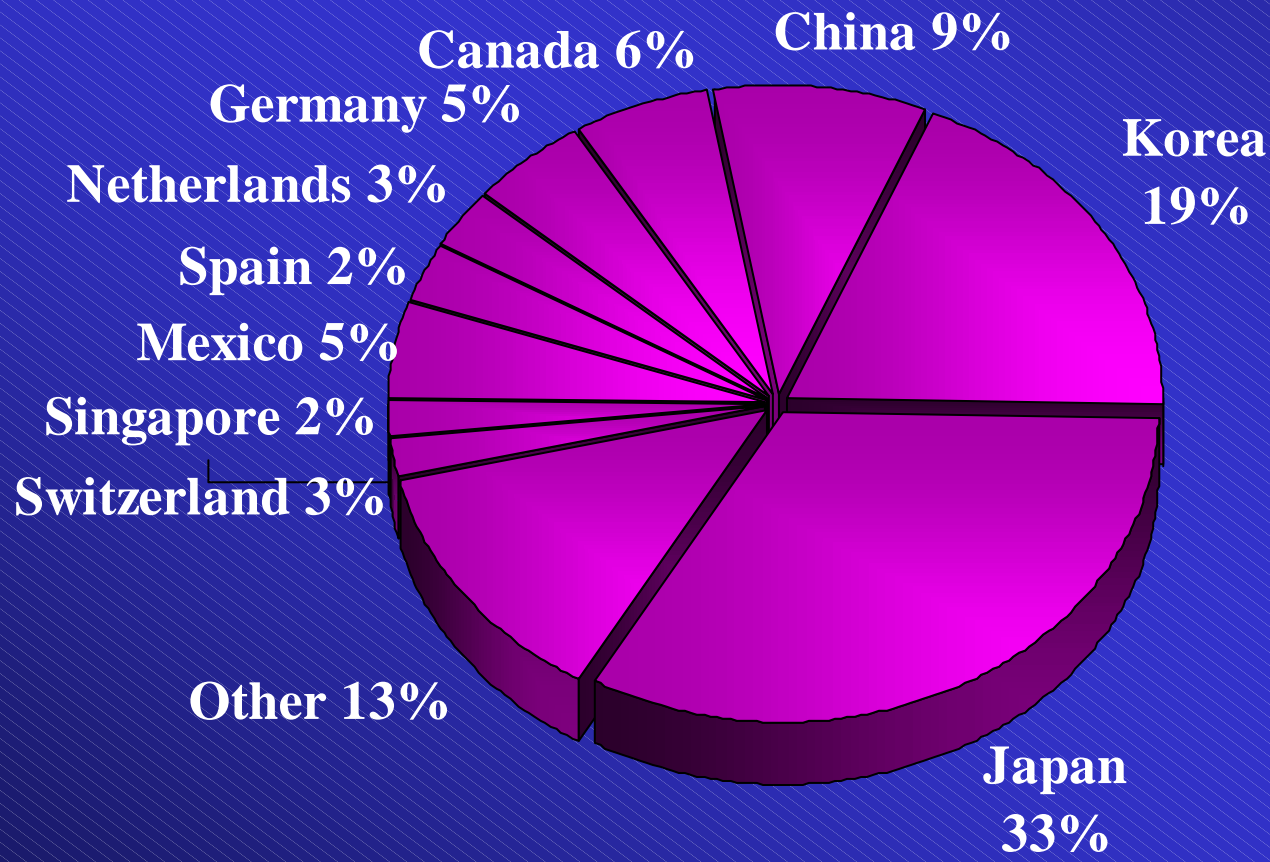
Alaska's Major International Export Products

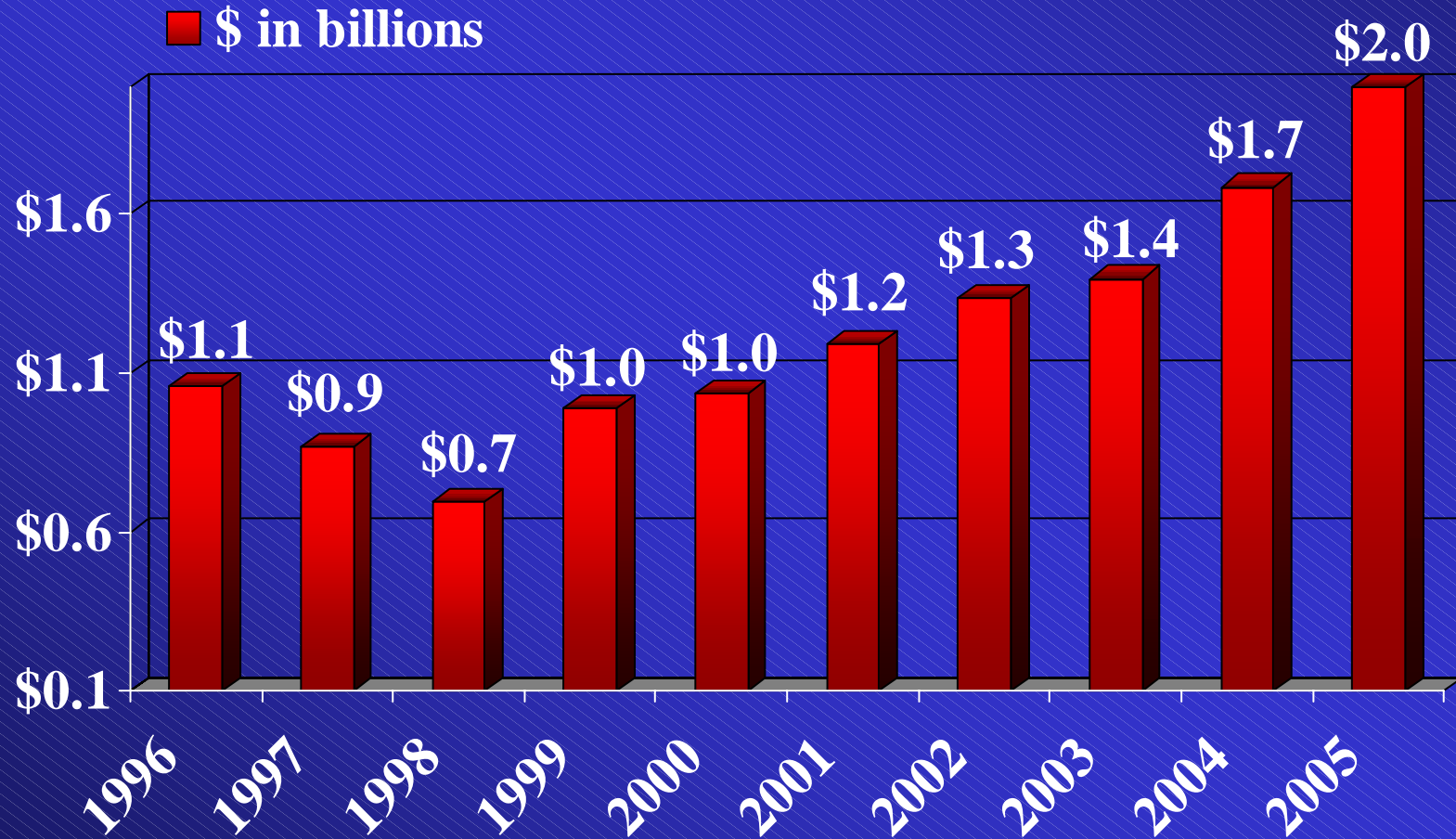
Alaska's International Export Destinations 2005

Alaska International Seafood Exports

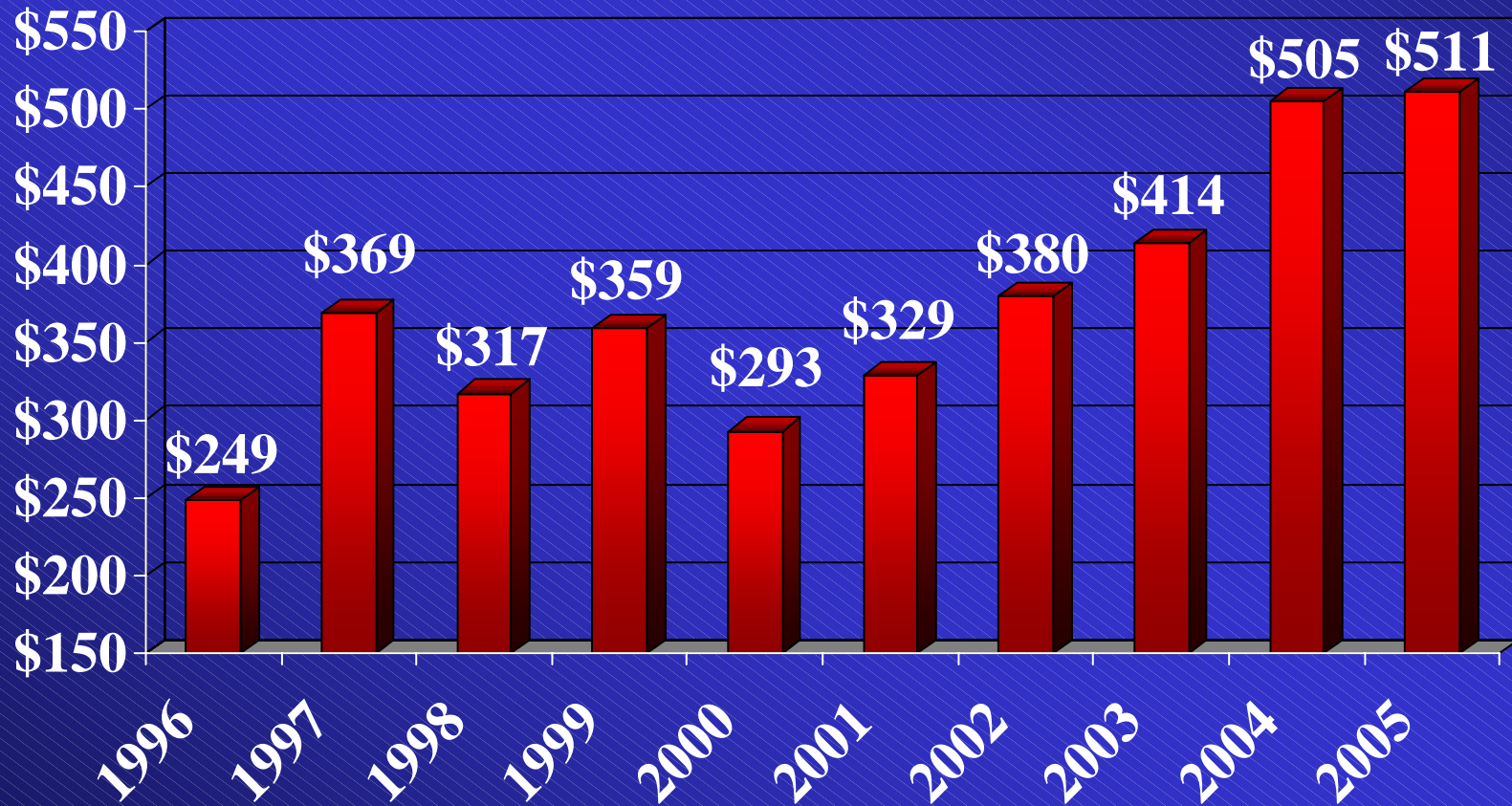

Alaska International Mineral Exports

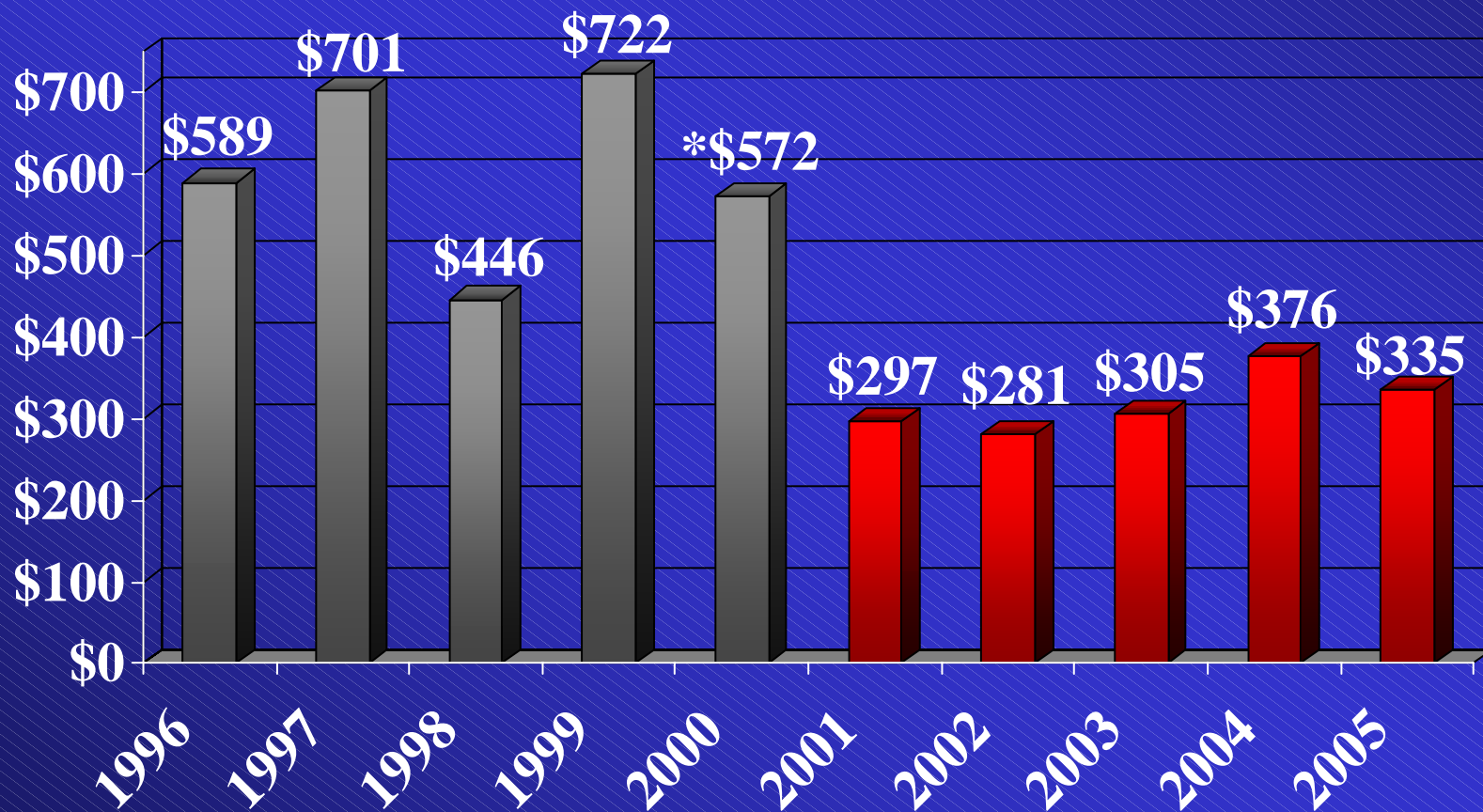

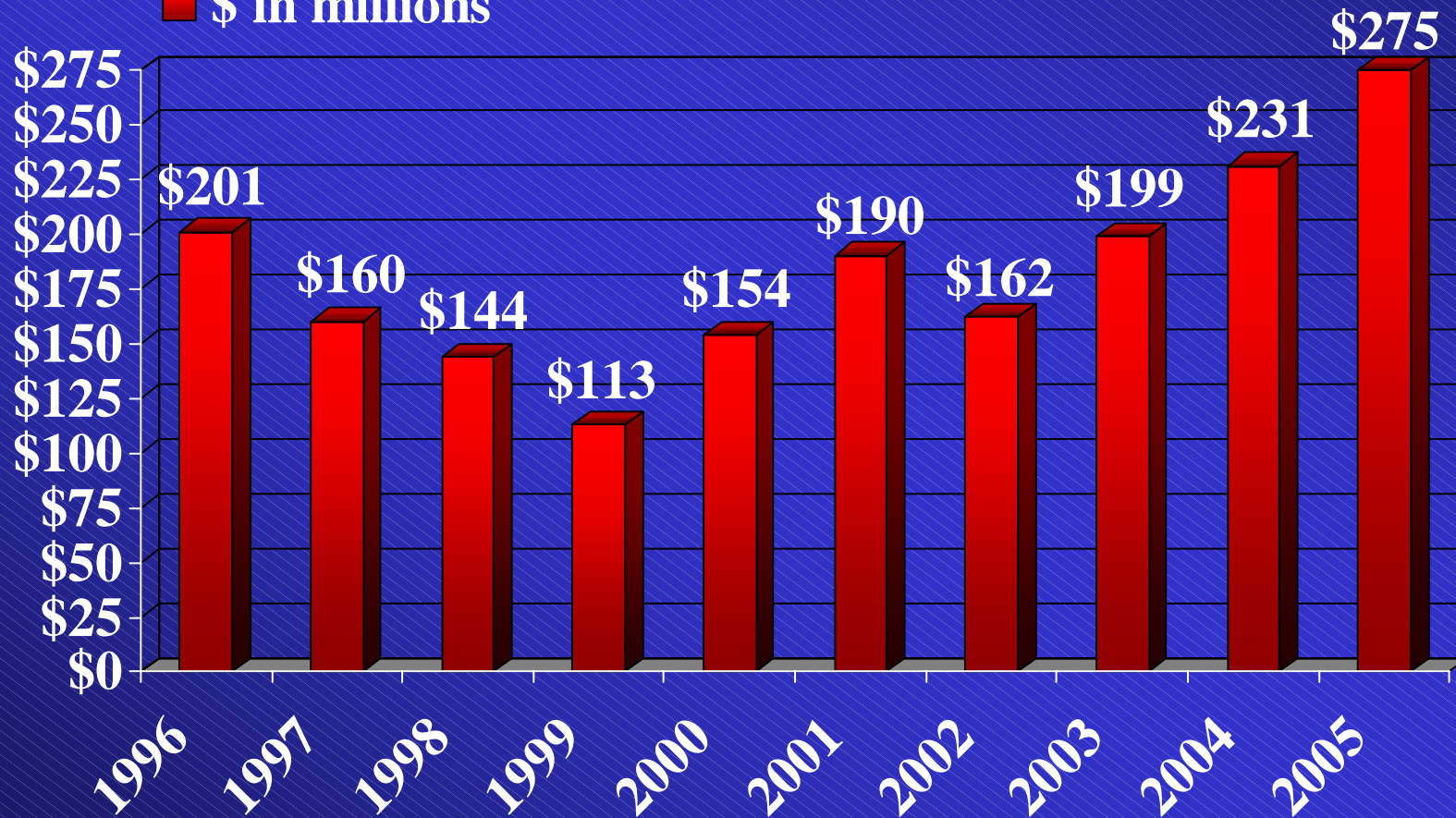
